USER GUIDE

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Read all instructions** and save them for personal reference in the future.
- **2.** Follow all directions for operating the product.
- **3. Heed all warnings** on the product and in the operation instructions.
- **4.** Clean with a dry cloth only. Always unplug the product from any power source before cleaning.
- **5. Do not use third-party attachments** or non-recommended accessories with this product.
- 6. Do not place product on an unstable surface, such as a cart, stand, tripod, table, etc. Unstable surfaces may cause the product to fall and cause serious injury to people and serious damage to the product. Follow all manufacturer instructions for mounting and accessories.
- 7. **Do not block or cover ventilation slots.** Openings in the product cabin ensure reliable operation and prevent overheating. Avoid placing on beds, sofas, and rugs, or mounting on racks or bookcases, unless proper ventilation is provided.







5. Pairing your Device

NOTE: If you synced speakers, you can only pair your device with the first speaker you turned on

TO PAIR (enable Bluetooth on your device)





PAIRED

If BT indicator is not flashing quickly, press and hold until it flashes quickly. Select "Nuvelon FLARE" from devices list

Solid light + chime indicates pairing successful





To disconnect user, press BT button 4–5 secs. (chime will sound when device is disconnected)

BLUETOOTH WAKE-UP



If your device is out of BT range for >5 mins, and disconnects, press BT button to pair again



II. CHARGE YOUR SPEAKERS

NOTE: speakers must be fully charged before use

- 1. Release port cover and plug power adapter pin (B) into charging port
- 2. Plug power adapter into power outlet
- 3. Charge until indicator light turns solid red and remove charging cord (full charge is reached after approximately 3 hours of charging)



SYNC TIPS

Please note the below tips to enhance your multi-sync experience!

1. SPEAKER SYNC SET UP PERIOD IS LIMITED TO 90 SECONDS AFTER TURNING THE FIRST SPEAKER ON.

Whether you are syncing a small or large number of speakers you may not be able to sync all your speakers within the 90 second time period. If this happens, follow these steps to continue syncing:

- (i) Press the sync button on the first speaker until sync light goes off
- (ii) Follow steps 3 and 4 on Page 7 to continue syncing speakers
- (iii) Press the sync button on any synced speakers that became unlinked

2. WHEN POWERING SYNCED SPEAKERS ON, DO SO WITHIN 90 SECONDS.

When you sync speakers they stay synced – meaning when you power synced speakers off they will automatically sync with each other again when powered on, but ONLY if you power all your synced speakers on within 90 seconds. If more than 90 seconds passes between powering on synced speakers, briefly press the SYNC button on the first speaker you turned on to reengage sync on all linked speakers.

3. CHOOSING A LOCATION FOR THE TRANSMITTING SPEAKER. As long as you turn it on <u>first</u>, when the transmitting speaker is powered off, it will also power off all speakers synced to it. For this reason, position the transmitting speaker in a convenient location where you can easily turn it on and off. (Please note that synced speakers need to be turned on individually.)

4. CHANGING A TRANSMITTING SPEAKER TO A RECEIVING SPEAKER.

If you wish to change a receiving speaker to a transmitting speaker: Turn it on first and follow steps 2 – 4 on Page 7 for syncing speakers, but continue to hold the sync button on the first speaker while you press the sync button on the transmitting speaker.


IV. BLUETOOTH PAIRING (speaker must be powered ON,

and Bluetooth must be enabled on your device)

NOTE: BLUETOOTH DEVICE AND SPEAKER SHOULD BE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY WHEN PAIRING (~3 ft./1m)

A. ESTABLISHING A NEW PAIRING (single speaker)

- 1. When speaker is powered ON for the first time, speaker enters Bluetooth pairing mode automatically (approximately 5 seconds after powering speaker ON) (if Bluetooth light does not flash quickly 5 seconds after powering speaker ON, press and hold BLUETOOTH button until it starts flashing quickly)
- 2. Enable Bluetooth in your device settings and select "Nuvelon FLARE"
- 3. Upon pairing, a chime will sound and the indicator light will remain lit



B. ESTABLISHING A NEW PAIRING (2 or more synced speakers)


Pair with the <u>first speaker</u> you turned on (transmitting light will be solid- see Page 7.)

Press BLUETOOTH button on first speaker until it flashes quickly, and follow steps 2 - 3 in section A. (ESTABLISHING A NEW PAIRING)

NOTE: After syncing and pairing, when speakers are powered ON again, pairing will automatically be established with the first speaker, **but can take up to 60 seconds**

C. DISCONNECT A DEVICE AND PAIR WITH A NEW DEVICE


- 1. When speaker is powered ON and last connected device is on and within range, pairing will be established automatically. To pair a new device, follow steps below:
- 2. Press and hold the BLUETOOTH button until the disconnection chime sounds and the Bluetooth indicator begins flashing quickly (about 5 seconds)
- 3. Follow steps 2 3 in section A. (ESTABLISHING A NEW PAIRING)



D. WAKE UP BLUETOOTH FROM SLEEP MODE

To save power, the Bluetooth connection will automatically go into sleep mode if your device stays out of Bluetooth range for more than 5 minutes.

To reconnect when your device is back within range, press the BLUETOOTH button to cancel sleep mode and re-establish pairing connection.




If you cannot pair a device, follow steps in C. above to ensure no other device is paired. If you experience difficulty with pairing, please contact customer care (SEE PAGE 12)

V. AUXILIARY INPUT

If your device has a 3.5mm audio jack, or is not Bluetooth enabled, you may use the included auxiliary cable to use the speaker without Bluetooth. When used this way, Bluetooth will be disabled, but speaker sync features remain fully functional.

- 1. Plug one end of the auxiliary cable into the speaker auxiliary port
- 2. Plug the other end of the auxiliary cable into your device audio jack (ensure audio jack is not obstructed by any protective case or accessories)
- 3. When auxiliary cable is plugged into speaker you will hear an audible chime and the auxiliary indicator will illuminate.



VI. LIGHT SHOW

NOTE: Color-changing Pulse feature DOES NOT WORK without playing music! By default, the lantern will turn off after 2 hours to extend run time. If you wish the lantern to illuminate for longer, please set the timer (see Section D. on page 11)

A. LANTERN ON/OFF AND BRIGHTNESS CONTROL

- 1. Press the <u>LIGHT SHOW</u> button to turn the lantern feature ON
- 2. Press again to turn lantern feature OFF
- 3. Each time you press the button again, the brightness of the light increases
- 4. Press button a total of 5 times to reach maximum brightness, then press again to turn lantern feature OFF

(Brightness level settings correspond to 20%, 40%, 60%, 80% and 100%)



B. LIGHT SHOW COLOR SELECTION (single speaker)

Lantern feature must be on to change light show color selections. See A. Above.

1. Press and release the <u>COLOR/TIMER</u> button to select the next light color Light shows are arranged in the following sequence:



C. LIGHT SHOW COLOR SELECTION (2 or more synced speakers)

When 2 or more speakers are synced, changing the light show color selection on the first speaker will change the light show on all synced speakers **EXCEPT** the color-changing pulse effect (which cannot sync between speakers)

Light show color/brightness/timer selections can also be changed individually on any synced speaker

D. TIMER OPTION

- 1. Press and HOLD the COLOR/TIMER button
- 2. When the desired timer interval lights up, release the button
- **3.** To change the timer interval, repeat steps 1. and 2. (Timer will revert to last selected timer interval when speaker is powered on)

You may set the timer to turn off the lantern after 2, 4, 6 or 8 hours



NOTE: By default, the lantern will turn off after 2 hours to extend run time


