





USB

A USB flash disk is needed (excluded in the list of accessories)

- 1. Insert the USB flash disk in the USB interface.
- 2. Press Sound Source Switching key repeatedly or the USB key on the remote control to switch to USB mode, then the purple indicator will keep on or show USb.
- 3. Ensure that your USB flash disk is stored with MP3 audio.

 If your USB flash disk is stored with MP3 audio, you can play it with the machine.
- 4. USB devices must be operated with the remote control. | pause/ play; | | |
- 5. previous track and next track; Replay: replay single track by pressing Replay key once or all tracks by pressing Replay key twice.

LINE IN

A 3.5 audio connecting cable is needed (included in the list of accessories)

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5 audio connecting cable to the audio output interface and the other end to the 3.5 LINE input interface of the machine.
- 2. Press the Sound Source Switching key repeatedly or the LINE key on the remote control to switch to LINE mode, then the green indicator will keep on or show Line.
- 3. Make sure that the audio setting of sound source is in "Connecting to Sound Equipment" status.
- 4. Play your sound source equipment with the machine.

Bluetooth

Initial pairing of Bluetooth

- 1. Press Sound Source Switching key repeatedly, or the Bluetooth key on the remote control to switch to Bluetooth mode, then the blue indicator will blink or blink **b**E.
- 2. Turn on the Bluetooth of your device and search ET018 and then click pairing. If the pairing is successful, the machine will make a prompt sound to indicate that your device can automatically connect to the machine.
- 3. Ensure that your Bluetooth device has been paired with the machine.
- 4. Play your sound source equipment with the machine.
- 5. If initial pairing succeeds, your device can automatically connect to the machine in the following operations after the Bluetooth of your device is turned on.
- 6. If your device cannot automatically connect to the machine, cancel the pairing and repeat steps 1/2/3/4.
