


## **How to Operate**

## **CHARGING the FH1**

It is a good idea to fully charge your new FH1 before using it. Here's how:




Plug the home charger into an outlet.



Plug the connector side into the port marked "**DC12V**" located on the control panel on the back of the FH1.



The "Charging" light will turn red indicating the FH1 is charging. A full charge can take up to 3 hours. A full charge is indicated by the "Charging" light turning green. Once the FH1 is charged you may unplug the charger connector.




When the "Aux" light starts flashing it is time to charge the FH1. Follow the instructions above for charging.

### **USING the FH1**



Turn on your phone or other wireless device Bluetooth and set to **discover** or **scan** mode.



In a few moments you will hear "Pairing Completed" followed by a tone.



If using a smartphone, we recommend turning down your notification volume so your play is not interrupted by notification tones.

**NOTE**: If you forget to charge the FH1, it will stop working even though the ON/OFF button is depressed.




Turn on the FH1 by pressing the On/Off button (()) located on the control panel on the back of the FH1. You will hear "Power On" and the "AUX" light will flash blue and stay lit.



When your device detects "Audio Icons FH1" please select.



You are now connected\* and ready to use your FH1. There is no need to pair again – it will be ready to use the next time you turn it on. Be sure your device Bluetooth is turned on each time.



To turn off the FH1 simply press the **On/Off button** ( $\bigcirc$ ) on the FH1 control panel. You will hear "**Power Off**" and the "**AUX**" light will flash and then turn off.

\*You can also connect a device by plugging an audio cable into your device's headphone jack and the other end into the FH1's AUX port.
