1. Attention And Instructions

For more enjoyable use of this product, please read this manual before using. Meanwhile, please fill the battery first when you use this product for the first time.

2. Operating Instructions

※ Buttons and interfaces



- ①charge LED
- ②power SW
- ③charging port
- ④bluetooth LED
- ⑤colorful-lights SW

⑦Volume down/next	1. Long Press: volume down 2. Short Press: next song	LP/SP all for Volume down
⑧play/pause/answer	1. Press one time: play/pause 2. press twice shortly : call back	1.Short Press to answer , Short Press to Reject 2、 long press to hang up
⑨Volume up/back	1. Long Press: Volume up 2. Short press: last song	LP/SP all for Volume up
Note: long press means hold down the button for more than 2 seconds, double-click means press 2 times the button in short time.		

3. Pairing bluetooth connection and charging

※Before using the product must make your product with your mobile phone or other bluetooth

device matching. Once the pairing connection is successful, the product is automatically connected when the device is used again.

※Please turn off other Bluetooth devices when pairing your headset. The specific operation is as follows:

a) Turn the power switch to ON position, the headset ④ Bluetooth LED (red) will flash quickly, the headset into the paired state, the device that needs to match can be connected to search the headset model. Such as: TBOTB138.

b) Opening the Bluetooth search function of device that you want to match, when searching for headset models. Such as: when headset models (eg TBOTB138) will be searched and click on the link Bluetooth LED ④ will turn blue slowly flashing after matching.

※when the Bluetooth LED flashing red at working time, it means that the headset power is too low, need to charge the battery.

※plugging the charging cable into the charging port with 5V power. Charging time will take 2-3 hours. Charging is completed when the charge LED is turned from red to blue.
