


1.Specifications

- 1) Micro USB Charging Port
- 2) On/Off Switch
- 3) AUX Port



2.Instructions

- 1) Slide the power switch to "On" to turn on the speaker.
- 2) Go to your device settings and activate the Bluetooth® feature, then search for devices. Find this speaker, which appears as "BT-CUP" on the device list, and pair. The voice prompt will alert you if the pairing is successful. (If pass-code is requested, enter "0000.")
- 3) Press the Play/Pause button on your device to play sound.
- 4) For Volume, adjust using your device's volume control.
- 5) You can use the included 3.5mm to 3.5mm audio cable to connect directly to your device from the speaker without using Bluetooth®. Plug the audio cable into your device, and plug the other end of the cable into the speaker's AUX port.
