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## 5 SAR Evaluation

### 5.1 RF Exposure Compliance Requirement

#### 5.1.1 Standard Requirement

According to KDB447498D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06

4.3.1. Standalone SAR test exclusion considerations

Unless specifically required by the published RF exposure KDB procedures, standalone 1-g head or body and 10-g extremity SAR evaluation for general population exposure conditions, by measurement or numerical simulation, is not required when the corresponding SAR Exclusion Threshold condition, listed below, is satisfied.

#### 5.1.2 Limits

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances  $\leq$  50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)]  $\cdot$  [ $\sqrt{f}(GHz)$ ]  $\leq$  3.0 for 1-g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR, where

f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz

Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation<sup>17</sup>

The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison

The test exclusions are applicable only when the minimum test separation distance is  $\leq$  50 mm and for transmission frequencies between 100 MHz and 6 GHz. When the minimum test separation distance is < 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm is applied to determine SAR test exclusion

#### 5.1.3 EUT RF Exposure

The Max. power (including tune-up tolerance) is 3.78 dBm on the highest channel 2.48 GHz (\*) 3.78 dBm logarithmic terms convert to numeric result is nearly 2.39 mW According to the formula. calculate the test exclusion thresholds:

simultaneous transmission SAR test exclusion =  $(0.75 / 5) \times (\sqrt{2.480} / 7.5) + (0.10 / 5) \times (\sqrt{2.457} / 7.5)$ = 0.034 W/Kg < 1.6 W/Kg
