

Product introduction


1. Main control block:
Main control block is the core part of BlockBots, electronic components and blocks can be assembled on it to build different movable robots.




2. Ultrasound block
Ultrasound block is just like the "eyes" of the BlockBots, the robots can identify distance and detect obstacles in the front through this part.



3. Steering engine block
Steering engine block provides "power" to BlockBots, driving rotation of blocks and sensors.



4. Connection
Plug the connector of ultrasound block and steering engine block into random socket on the back of main control block.




Set-Up

1. Download the App
Search for "BlockBots" on the App Store. Download and install the app.


2. Connect the main control

- Open the APP and click on the connection icon at the top right. The icon shows in grey if connection fails.
- Turn on Bluetooth of the electronic device following the instructions of the flash.
- Turn on the power on the back of main control following the instructions of the flash.
- Keep your electronic device within 20cm range with the main control to connect them following the instructions of the flash.
- When appears, then you have successfully connected the device with main control.
- The connection icon at the top right turns orange after successful connection.




2. Connect the Bluetooth audio

- Open the APP and click on the connection icon at the top right.
- Click on "Connect" button below Bluetooth speaker.
- Click on "Settings" in the pop-up to jump to setting page.
- Choose and turn on "Bluetooth" on setting page, click on "BlockBots AUDIO xxxx" to connect.




Device status will show "connected" on the page when successfully connected.
