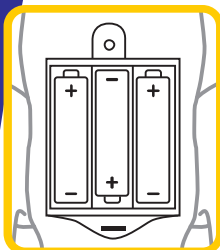
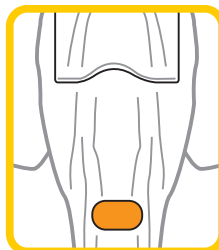


Trex Projector

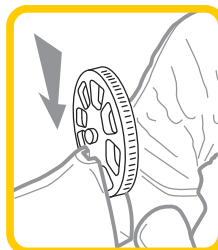
& Room Guard



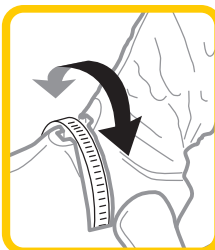
Unscrew the battery cover with a Philips screwdriver and insert 3 AA (1.5V LR6) batteries, noting the battery guidelines below. Replace the cover and screw it back in place. Batteries not included.



Turn ON your T rex by pressing the orange button beneath the tail. Your T rex will give a mighty ROAR!



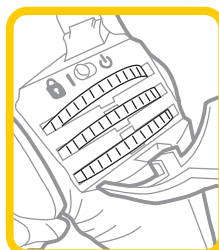
PROJECTOR There are three discs with 24 dinosaur images in total. Insert one disc into the slot on top of the T rex.



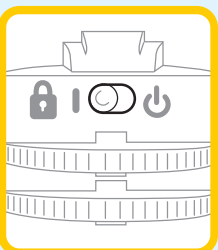
Turn the disc to select the image.



To focus the image, gently move the right arm up and down.



Hidden storage area for your discs.



ROOM GUARD Leave the T rex switched on via the orange button under the tail. The orange Room Guard switch, indicated with a lock symbol, is in the disc storage area. Switch the Room Guard to the ON position. The

motion sensor is in the chest of the T rex. If movement is detected by the motion sensor, up to 1.5 metres away, your T rex will ROAR. A trembler alert will make your T rex ROAR if picked up and will only stop roaring when put back down again.

Note: The motion sensor is activated by changes in light patterns, so will not work in a dark room. This is a toy and is not a substitute for an alarm system. When the Room Guard is ON the Projector is automatically switched OFF. Turn OFF the Room Guard switch and the button beneath the tail to preserve battery life.
