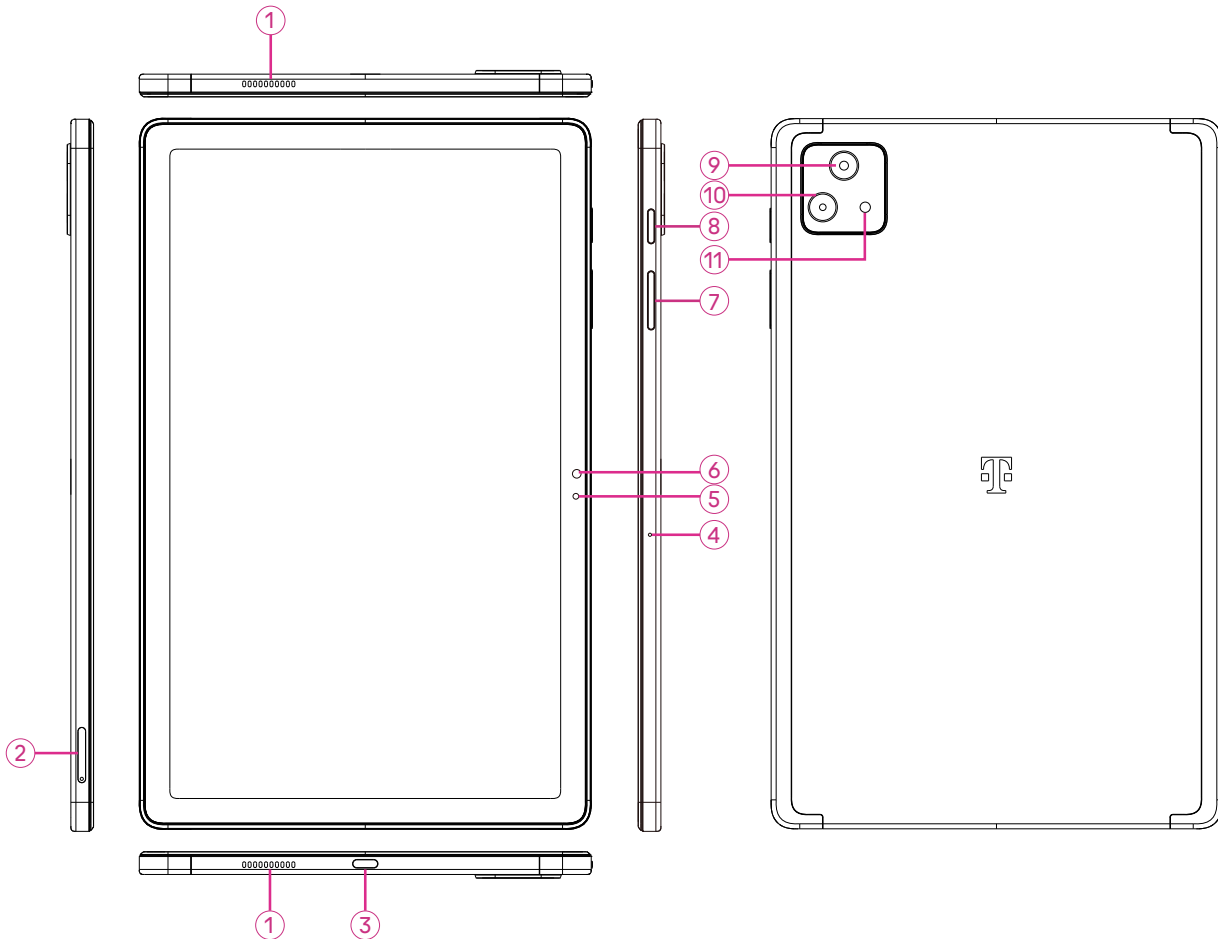

1.1 Overview

Power button

- Press and release quickly to lock or light up the screen.
- Press and hold to launch **Google Assistant**.
- Press and hold the **Power** key and **Volume up** key to select from Power off or Restart.
- Press and hold the **Power** key and **Volume down** key to take a screenshot and save it.
- Press and hold the **Power** key and **Volume up** key for at least 10 seconds to force reboot.
- Press the **Power** key twice to access the camera.

Volume button

- Use the Volume up or down keys to adjust the ringtone volume, or the media volume while listening to music, watching a video, or streaming content.
- While using the Camera, press the Volume up or down key to take a photo.

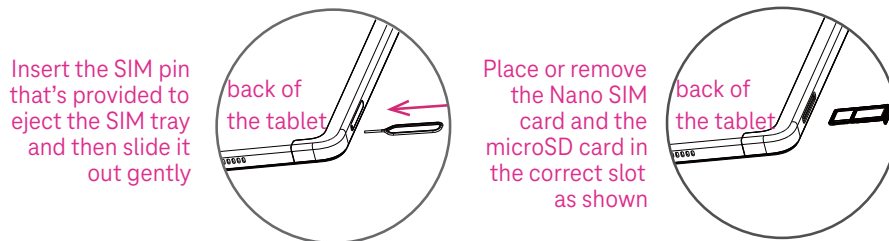
1.2 Set up

Inserting Nano SIM card

You must insert your Nano SIM card to make tablet messages using your network.



Your tablet only supports Nano SIM cards. In order to avoid damaging your tablet, do not attempt to insert other SIM types, such as Mini or Micro cards.



Note: Even if no SIM card is installed, your tablet will still power on and you will be able to connect to a Wi-Fi network and use some of the tablet's features.

Register an E-sim

- Connect to WiFi, touch **Settings** > **Mobile network** > +.
- Touch **Download a SIM instead?** > **Next**.
- Scan QR code and wait for Downloading.
- After downloading, touch **Settings** to set E-sim.

Set E-sim

After downloading E-sim configuration document, access to Mobile network, choose the E-sim document and touch **YES**.

Delete E-sim configuration document

Connect the device to WiFi or mobile data. Touch **Settings** > **Mobile network** > **Carrier** >  > **DELETE**.

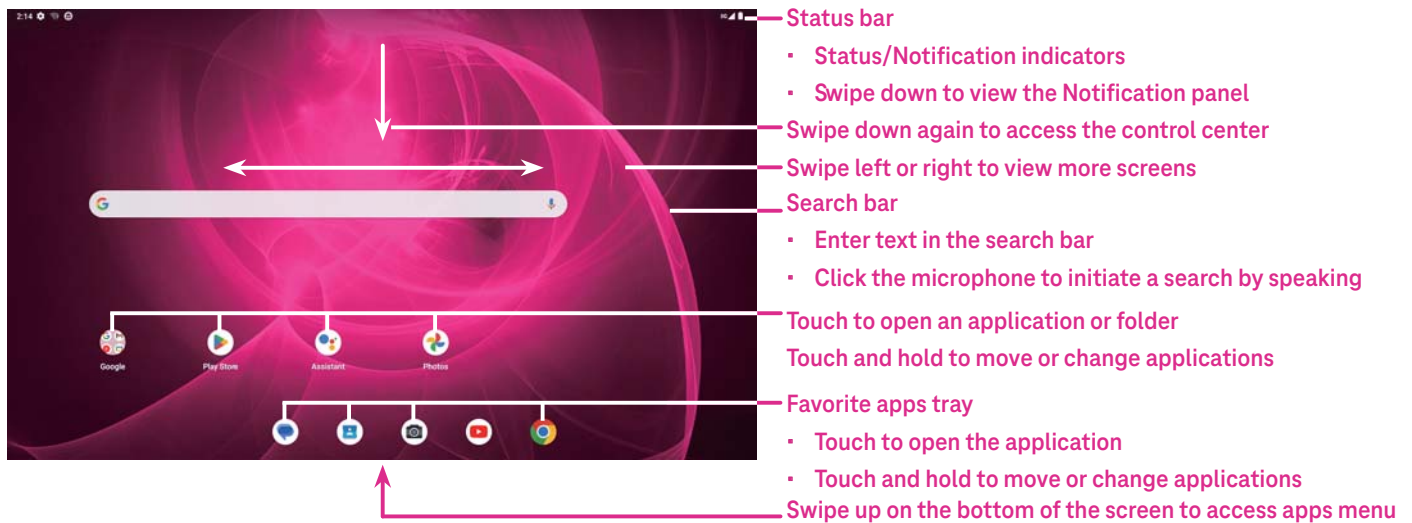
Set up your tablet

The first time you power on the tablet, you should set the following options:

- Touch **English (United States)** to choose your language, and touch **Vision settings** to customize accessibility features. When finished, touch **Start** on original interface to go on.
- Select an available Wi-Fi network. Or touch **Set up offline** and **Continue**.
- Toggle to allow the tablet to use location, otherwise toggle off .
- Toggle to allow scanning, otherwise toggle off .
- Toggle to allow to send usage and diagnostic data, otherwise toggle off .
- Click **Accept** to continue.
- Set a PIN for screen lock, otherwise touch **Skip** > **Skip anyway** to continue.













1.3 Home screen

You can bring all of the items that you use most frequently (applications, shortcuts, widgets, folders) to your Home screen for quick access.



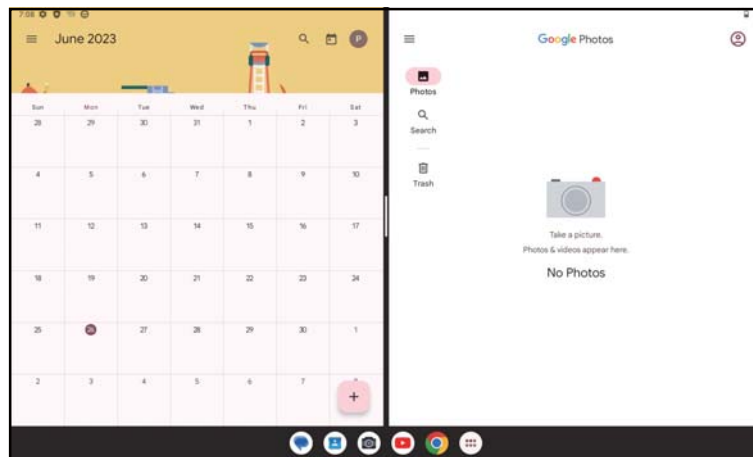
1.4 Status bar

The Status bar appears at the top of your Home screen and includes icons indicating your tablet's status and new notification alerts.

1.5 Split screen mode

You can set split screen mode to show two different interfaces on the tablet at the same time.





Using split screen mode

Hold the app you want to access, then tap **Split right** or **Split left**. Choose another app to use split screen.


Note: If there is nothing in recently used app interface, you can not use split screen mode.

Settings split screen mode

In split screen mode, you can adjust the split screen size by sliding  in the middle of two screens.

Or exchange two screens' place by tapping  twice.

Exiting split screen mode

In split screen mode, you can slide  to the edge of the screen.

2 About your tablet.....

2.1 Power on/off

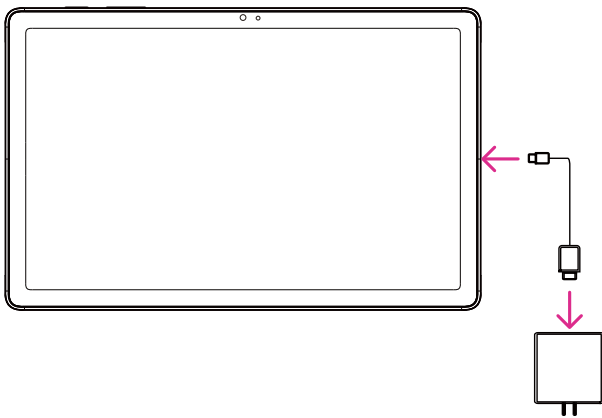
To turn the device on, hold down the **Power** key until the tablet powers on. Unlock your tablet (using None, Swipe, Pattern, PIN, Password or Face key) if necessary. Once unlocked, the Home screen is displayed.

If you don't know your PIN code or if you have forgotten it, contact Customer Care. For safety, please do not store PIN code in your tablet.

To power the device off, press the **Power** key and **Volume up** key until options appear, then select **Power off**.

Charging

Insert the small end of the charging cable into the charge port and plug the charger into an electrical outlet.



- Insert the USB type-C cable into the charge port as shown.
- Connect charger to power outlet.

Note: Please use the USB type-C cable included in the box. Wall charger sold separately. Using the wrong cable and charger may damage the charging port or reduce battery performance.

2.2 Battery


Make these adjustments to optimize your battery life.

Turn on power saving mode

- Go to **Settings > Battery > Battery Saver**.
- Touch **Use Battery Saver > TURN ON** to activate the battery saving mode.

Note: The Battery Saver mode will not be activated in charging mode.

Lower screen brightness

- Go to **Settings > Display > Brightness level**.
- Lower the brightness by sliding  to the left.


Screen timeout

- Go to **Settings > Display > Screen timeout**.
- Select the screen timeout duration.

3 Personalize your tablet.....

3.1 Language


Choose from multiple languages supported on your device.

- Go to **Settings > System > Languages & input > Languages**.
- Touch + **Add a language** to select a language from the list.
- Touch and hold  next to your desired language and drag it to the top of the list.

3.2 Date & time

Go to **Settings > System > Date & time**.

Use network-provided time


Touch **Set time automatically** to locate . Choose between:

- Use network-provided time
- Use GPS-provided time
- Off

If choose **Off**, you can manually set the date and time:

- Touch **Set date** to open a dialog in which you can manually set the date.
- Touch **Set time** to open a dialog in which you can manually set the time.



Automatic time zone

Turn on  to enable the network-provided time zone. And you can turn on **Use location to set time zone** to allow tablet time to be matched with local time.

If Automatic time zone is turned off, you can manually set the time zone:

- Touch **Select time zone** to select the region and time zone manually.

Use locale default

- Turn on  to enable locale default.
- If **Use locale default** is off, you can turn on  to enable the **Use 24-hour format**.

3.3 Display

Make adjustments to the display settings and wallpapers to optimize your experience.

Go to **Settings > Display** to alter the following settings.

Dark theme

Dark theme uses a black background and help keep battery alive longer on some screens.

Night light

This mode tints your screen amber. This makes it easier to look at your screen or read in dim light, and may help you fall asleep more easily.

Auto-rotate screen

Select whether the screen rotates automatically or not.

Note: Using your device in landscape mode while wearing polarized sunglasses may cut light from the screen. Take your polarized sunglasses off or use your device in portrait orientation to continue use.

Lock screen

Customize what displays on your lock screen.

3.4 Wallpaper

- Touch Photos to select from images that are stored on your device.
- Touch **Settings > Wallpaper & style** to change a wallpaper for your lock screen and/or homescreen from pre-loaded images.

3.5 Sound

Adjusting volume

- Press the volume keys that are located on the right side of the device to adjust the Ringtone & Notification volume.
- You can also go to **Settings > Sound** to adjust the volume for media, alarm and notification.

Adjusting other sounds

All other sounds that are related to notification, media, alarm, screen locking, charging and touching can be adjusted to by doing the following:

Go to **Settings > Sound**.

3.6 Digital Wellbeing & parental controls

- Go to **Settings** and touch **Digital Wellbeing & parental controls** to find out how much time you have spent on the tablet and even on each app. You can customize the time limit for using the tablet.
- In addition, parents can restrict their children's usage time and manage their browsing habits.

3.7 Gestures

You can change the system navigation by going to **Settings > System > Gestures > System navigation**, then choose one type of navigation.

Gesture navigation

Touch **Gesture navigation** to enable different interfaces access by swiping the tablet screen.

- Go to recent apps interface: swipe up from the bottom of the screen, and hold.
- Go home: swipe up from the bottom of the screen.
- Go back: swipe from either the left or right edge of the screen.

3-button navigation

Touch **3-button navigation** to display the following buttons on the bottom of the screen.

■ Recent Apps button

- Touch to view recently used applications. Swipe up on the screen to remove a specific thumbnail from the list, or scroll all the way to the left and touch **CLEAR ALL** to remove all thumbnails from the list.
- Pressing the **Recent Apps** button will also allow access to **Screenshot**. Touch **Screenshot** to immediately capture what is on the screen.

● Home button

- From any application or screen, touch to return to the Home screen.
- Touch and hold to launch Google Assistant, with which you can search for information online, open apps on your tablet, or send messages.

◀ Back button

Touch to go back to the previous screen, or to close a dialog box, options menu, or the Notification panel.

3.8 Multiple users

You can share your tablet with other users by going to **Settings > System > Multiple users**, then turn on . And you will see the following choices.

- You (Owner): Touch it and you can set your profile information.
- Add guest: Touch it to create new guest and finish other settings.
- Add user: Touch it to add new user and allow him to set up his space.

Note: Touch **Add users from lock screen to allow user adding in lock screen**.

3.9 Backup & Factory Reset

- To transfer data from your device to another one, go to **Settings > System > Backup > Back up to Google Drive**, then you need set your backup account.
- To wipe all data in your device, go to **Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset) > Erase all data > Erase all data**. Then the tablet will restart.

4 Applications.....



4.1 Contacts

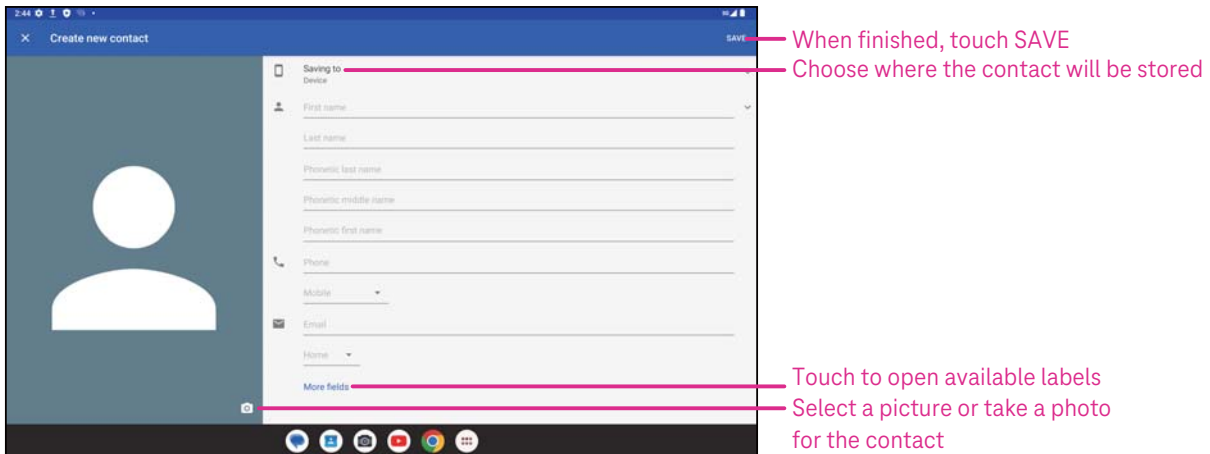
Contacts enables quick and easy access to the contact you want to reach.

To access this function, touch Contacts  from the Apps menu.

You can view and create contacts on your tablet and synchronize them with your Gmail contacts or other applications on the web or on your tablet.

Adding a contact



- Touch  in the contact list to create a new contact.
- Enter the contact's name and other contact information.
- When finished, touch **Save**.
- To exit without saving, you can touch  and then touch **Discard**.



Editing your contacts



Touch  in the contact details screen to edit. When finished, touch **SAVE**.

Add to/remove from Favorites⁽¹⁾

- Touch a contact to view details then touch  to add the contact to favorites.
- Touch  again to remove a contact from favorites.

Deleting a contact

From the contact list screen:

- Touch and hold the contact you want to delete, then touch  and **DELETE** to delete.
- Mark the checkbox of all contacts, then touch  and **DELETE** to delete all contacts.


From the contact details screen:

- Touch  then select **Delete**. Select **DELETE** when prompted to confirm.



The contact you have deleted will also be removed from other applications on the tablet or web the next time you synchronize your tablet.

Sharing a contact

You can share a single contact with others by sending the contact's vCard to them via Messages, Email, and Bluetooth. Select a contact you want to share, touch  and then select **Share**.


Available options

From the contact list, you may also make further adjustments by touching  > **Settings**.


Settings:

- My info Touch to set up your profile.
- Accounts Touch to add account and configure related info.
- Default account for new contacts Touch to choose the default place to save a new contact.
- Contacts to display Touch to depend whether all contacts will be displayed.
- Sort by Touch to sort the list by the first name or last name.
- Name format Touch to choose whether to display first name first or last name first.
- Phonetic name Touch to choose display or hide phonetic name.
- Import/ Export Import or export contacts between tablet, SIM card, microSD card and tablet storage.
- About Contacts Touch to view build version or service information.




4.2 Messages

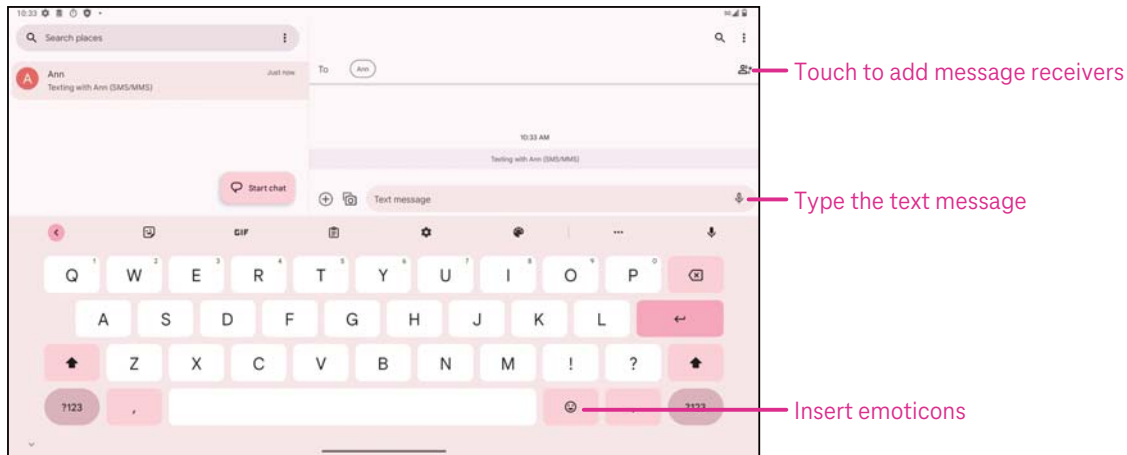
Use the messaging app  to send and receive text (SMS) and multimedia (MMS) messages.

Creating a message

On the Messaging list screen, touch  to write text/multimedia messages.

Sending a text message

- Enter the name, phone number or email of the recipient in the **To** bar or touch  to add recipients.
- Touch the **Text message** bar to enter the text of the message.
- Press and hold  to access emoticons.
- When finished, touch  to send the text message.






An SMS message of more than 160 characters will be charged as several SMS. A counter will be on the right of the text box to remind you how many characters can be entered in one message.




Specific letters (accented) will also increase the size of the SMS, this may cause multiple SMS to be sent to your recipient.

Sending a multimedia message

MMS enables you to send video clips, images, audio and vCard to other compatible mobiles and e-mail addresses.








- Enter the recipient's phone number in the **To** bar.
- Touch the **Text message** bar to enter the text of the message.
- Touch  to attach a emotion, your location, contact or file; Touch  to choose a picture or video.
- When finished, touch  to send the multimedia message.

Managing messages

When receiving a message,  will appear on the Status bar as a notification. Drag down the Status bar to open the Notification panel, touch the new message to open and read it. You can also access the Messaging application and touch the message to open it.

Messages are displayed as a conversation.

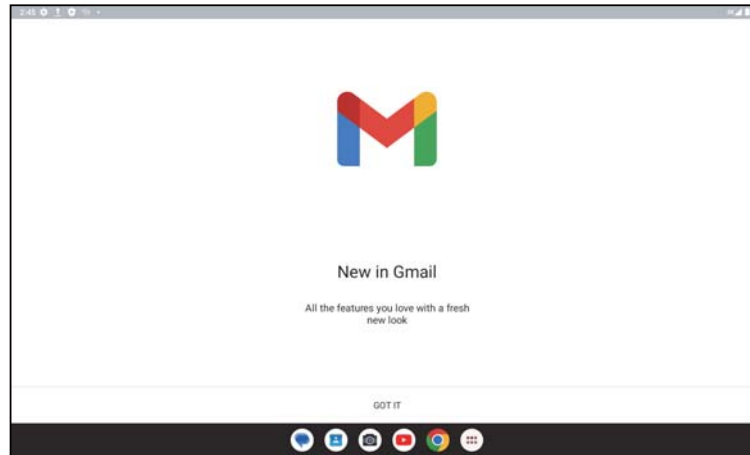
Touch a message to enter the message composing screen:

- Touch  to save the number to contacts, view the contact details, archive or delete the message.
- To reply to a message, enter the text. When finished, touch .
- If you touch and hold a message, the following options will be available:  copy,  delete,  share,  add to favorite, and  Forward, View details.

4.3 Gmail

Setting up Gmail

To set up your email account, swipe up from the Home screen, then tap folder **Google** and select **Gmail**.



- Select **+** to add an email address.
- An email setup process will guide you through the steps to set up an email account.
- Select the type of email account that you have and enter the email address and password of the account you want to set up.
- If the account you entered is not provided by your service provider in the device, touch **Other** and enter the email address, touch **NEXT** to select an account type and enter password of your email, then correctly fill in server and port in both Incoming server settings and Outgoing server settings interfaces. Touch **Finish** to complete setup.
- To add another email account, click **+ Add an email address**. Choose Other from the set up email options. Or you can touch the account name on the upper right corner and select **Add another account** to implement this function (this is unavailable when not log in Google).

Sending an email


- Touch **Compose** from the Inbox screen.
- Enter recipient(s) email address(es) in the **To** field.
- If necessary, touch **>Cc/Bcc** to add a copy or a blind copy to the message.
- Enter the subject and the content of the message.
- Touch **Attachment** to add an attachment.
- If you do not want to send the mail right away, you can touch **More** and **Save draft** or touch the Back key to save a copy.
- Touch **Send** to send.
- If you do not want to send or save the email, you can touch **More** and then select **Discard**.
- To add a signature that will appear on all of your emails, touch **More** and select **Settings**, then choose the account that you want to create or modify the signature, touch **Mobile signature** to edit.

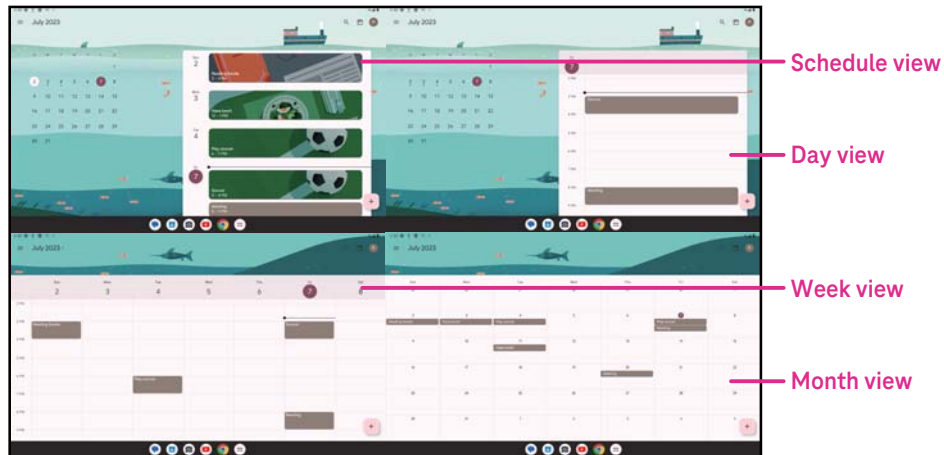
4.4 Calendar

You can use Calendar to keep track of important meetings, appointments, and more.

To access the function, swipe up from the Home screen, then touch **Calendar**.



Viewing calendars


You can display the Calendar in Schedule, Day, Week or Month view. Touch  and select your desired calendar view.





Creating a new event

You can add new events from any Calendar view.

- Touch .
- Fill in all required information for this new event. If it is a whole-day event, you can turn  on to All-day.
- Invite guests to the event. Enter the email addresses separated by commas of the guests you want to invite to separate. The guests will receive an invitation from Calendar and Email.
- When finished, touch **Save** from the top of the screen.

To quickly create an event from the Day, week, or month views, touch an empty spot to select a target area which will then turn into , and touch the icon to create the new event.

Deleting or editing an event

- To delete or edit an event, touch the event to enter its details screen, then touch  to edit the event.
- Touch  and **Delete** to remove the event, or **Duplicate** to copy the event.

Event reminder

If a reminder is set for an event, the upcoming event will appear in the home screen.



- Touch an event name to view the Calendar notification list.

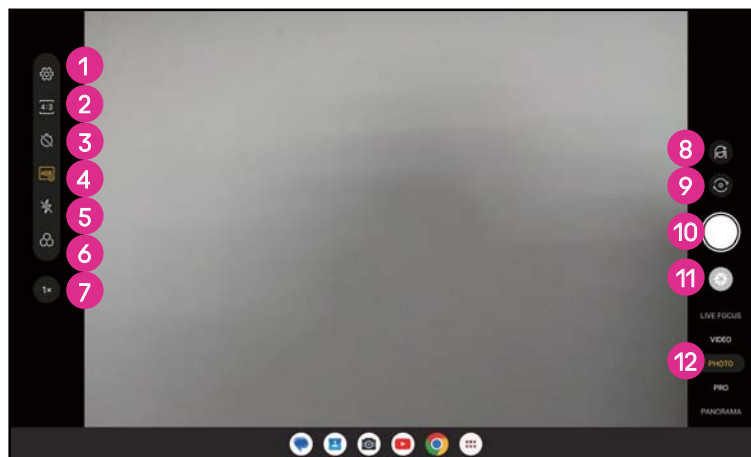
4.5 Camera

Accessing the camera

From the Home screen, touch **Camera**.




Taking a picture

- Position the object or landscape in the viewfinder, and touch the screen to focus if necessary.
- Touch  to take the picture which will be automatically saved.
- To take burst shots, touch and hold .

Making a video

- Touch **VIDEO** to enter the Video mode.
- Touch  in the center of the screen to start video recording.
- You can also touch  to take a picture during video recording.
- Touch  to stop recording. The video will be automatically saved.

Viewing, Editing, & Sharing

- Touch  then choose a way like **Messages** to share the photo or video.
- Touch  to edit.
- Touch  to search what you see with Google Lens.
- Touch  to delete.
- Touch  to go back to Camera mode.

4.6 Photos




Photos acts as a media player for you to view photos and play videos.

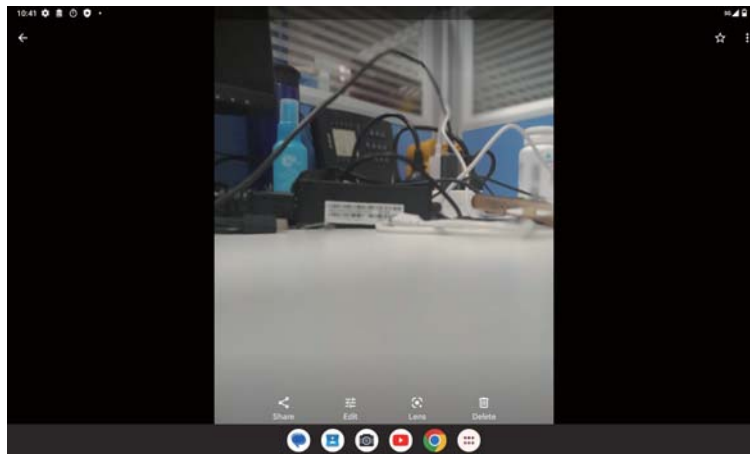
Pictures and videos are displayed by moments and albums in Photos.


- Touch the picture/video directly to view or play.
- Swipe left/right to view previous or next pictures/videos.

Working with photos

You can work with pictures by rotating or cropping them, sharing them with friends, setting them as a contact photo or wallpaper, etc.

- Locate the picture you want to work on and touch the picture in the full screen picture view.
- Touch  to share the picture, or touch  to delete the picture. Touch  and select **Use as** to set the picture as Contact photo or Wallpaper.





Tap  to enter editing screen.

Suggestions	Choose Enhance, Warm, Cool to adjust the picture color.
Crop	Select between Auto, Crop, Rotate, Preview, and Reset.
Adjust	Manage brightness, contrast, and more.
Filters	Choose between a variety such as Vivid, West, Palma, and more.
Markup	Personalize your picture by drawing on it or adding words to it.




4.7 Clock





To access Clock, swipe up from the Home screen, then touch **Clock**.

Setting world clocks







- Touch  on the clock screen.
- Touch  to add a time zone.

Setting alarms






- Touch  on the clock screen.
- Turn on  to enable existing alarm, or touch  to add a new alarm. The following options will appear:

-  **Add label** Touch to set a name for the alarm.
-  **Schedule alarm** Touch to select the date of the setting alarm.
-  **Ringtone** Touch to select a ringtone for the alarm.
- Dismiss** Touch to dismiss the alarm.
-  **Delete** Touch to delete the alarm.

Setting timer

- Touch  on the clock screen.
- Enter time in the sequence of seconds, minutes, and hours.
- Touch  to activate Countdown.
- Touch  to add another timer in panel.
- Touch  to deactivate Countdown.
- Touch  to activate Countdown.
- Touch  to delete current countdown timer.

Setting stopwatch

- Touch  on the clock screen.
- Touch  to start the timer.
- Touch  to show a list of records according to the updated time.
- Touch  to halt the total and lap times.
- Touch  to clear all new timers.

Bedtime

Set a bedtime to silence your tablet and choose to listen to soothing sounds. Set a wakeup time to receive alerts again.

5 Google applications.....

Google apps are preinstalled on your tablet to improve work efficiency and provide an enjoyable user experience.

This manual briefly introduces the apps. For detailed features and user guides, refer to related websites or the introduction provided in the apps.

Register with a Google Account to enjoy full functionality.



Google

Your bookmarks, browsing history, and settings across all devices on which the browser is installed can be synchronized with your Google Account.



Gmail

As Google's web-based email service, Gmail is configured when you first set up your tablet. With this application, you can send and receive emails, manage emails by labels, archive them, and more. Emails can be automatically synchronized with your Gmail account.



Maps

Google Maps offers satellite imagery, street maps, 360° panoramic views of streets, real-time traffic conditions, and route planning for traveling by foot, car, or public transportation. By using this application, you can find your own location, search for a place, and get suggested route planning for your trips.



YouTube

YouTube is an online video-sharing application where users can upload, view, and share videos. Available content includes video clips, TV clips, music videos, and other content such as video blogging, short original videos, and educational videos. It supports a streaming function that allows you to start watching videos almost as soon as they begin downloading from the internet.



Drive

A file storage and synchronization service created by Google, which allows users to store files in the cloud, share and edit files. Files in Drive are kept secure and can be accessed from any device by logging in to your Google Account. Files or folders can be shared privately with other Google Account users.



Meet

This is a video chat mobile app that allows users to make video calls to people in their contact list once their phone numbers are verified.



Photos

Google Photos stores and backs up your photos and videos. It also automatically analyzes photos and organizes them into groups so that you can quickly find the photos you need.



YT Music

YT Music Downloader is a Windows program that simplifies downloading videos and music from YouTube. YT Music Downloader lets you download videos and/or audio from YouTube. The program is geared toward music, so you can save music videos (or any videos) or convert those videos to just music, and the app will automatically save them in the MP3 format. Provided an appropriate YouTube link, the program is very fast at converting and saving these items to file, and once done, you have access to this music offline and via any others devices to which you transfer these files.



Play Store

Serves as the official app store for the Android operating system, allowing users to browse and download applications and games. Applications are either free of charge or at a cost.



Files

Files displays all data stored on the tablet, including both external SD card and internal storage, such as applications, media files downloaded from Google Play Store, YouTube or other locations; videos, pictures or audio you have captured; other data transferred via Bluetooth, USB cable, etc.



Chrome

Enjoy surfing the Web using the Chrome browser.



Assistant

Google Assistant helps you get everyday tasks done more easily. Set reminders, get quick answers, find directions with Google Maps, and more while on-the-go with the help of your Google Assistant.



Calculator

You can use calculator to add, subtract, multiply, and divide numbers. You can also raise a number to a power, find a number's square root, add and subtract a specific percentage, and even find the percentage of a number.



Calendar

You can create as many calendars as you want and share them to your friends. And calendar will show you your schedule to help you to arrange your time seamlessly.



Clock

Clock helps you to manage your time reasonably. You can set alarms, countdowns and so on.



Find Device

Allow your device to lock or erase a lost device.



Google One

The Google One app lets you back up your tablet and manage your Google account storage.



Google TV

Google TV makes it easy to find and enjoy the entertainment you love in one place. With Google TV, you'll be able to: Find what to watch next.



Home

With Google Home, you can create a more organized and personalized smart home. Set up, manage, and control your Google Nest, Wifi, or other compatible smart home products like lights, cameras and more.



Messages

Send SMS and MMS message. Unlimited texts, photos, videos, documents, emoticons and so on can be shared to your contacts.



Wallet

Enable users to pay for merchandise at retail outlets with tablets. Google Wallet supports loyalty and gift cards as well as payments between individuals via Gmail.



YT Kids

An app made just for kids, including all kinds of videos for all kinds of kids. And parental controls are available to set content levels by age.



Safety

An app about safety settings. Here you can set emergency response, detection & alerts, emergency contacts information and so on.

6 Security.....

6.1 Screen lock

Swipe up from the Home screen, access **Settings** in the apps list. Go to **Security > Screen lock**.

Screen lock allows you to secure your tablet from being used by others without your permission. Activate the following security options: Pattern, PIN, or Password. Whoever turns on your tablet will be required to unlock the screen in order to access your device. Your device can be unlocked by anyone if you select None or Swipe.

6.2 Face Unlock

Face unlock allows you to unlock your device with your facial data. Set it according to the on-screen steps. Make sure you are facing the tablet screen when using face recognition.

Note: you need to set a pattern, PIN, or password before using face unlock.

6.3 Smart Lock

Under **More security settings**, this function is inactive by default; you need to set a screen lock to activate it. If Smart lock is turned on, your device remains unlocked when it is safe with you.

6.4 SIM card lock

Under **More security settings**, a SIM PIN prevents access to the cellular data networks. When it's enabled, any device containing the SIM card will request the PIN upon restart. A SIM PIN is not the same as the lock code used to unlock the device.

6.5 Encryption & credentials

Under **More security settings**, touch to view your device encryption status and the credentials items. You can modify and clear all of the stored credentials.

7 Account

7.1 Account information

You can also access account information from your tablet.

- Go to **Settings > Passwords & accounts**.

7.2 Software update

To access Software Updates, follow the steps below:

- Connect your device to a Wi-Fi network and make sure it has a strong data connection.
- Ensure your battery is fully charged before starting the software update. Your device's current battery level can be found on your device under **Settings > Battery**.
- Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
- If you want to update the system, tap **Check for update** and when that's finished, your tablet will have the latest version of the software.

9 Troubleshooting.....

Review some of these common issues and their solutions.

I can't find my contacts

- Make sure that your SIM card is not broken.
- Make sure that your SIM card is inserted properly.
- Import all contacts stored in SIM card to tablet.

I can't use the features described in the manual

- Check to make sure that your subscription includes this service.
- Make sure that this feature doesn't require any additional accessory.

My tablet can't connect to a network or "No service" is displayed

- Try connecting to the network by moving to another physical location.
- Verify the network coverage in your current area.
- Check that your SIM card is valid.
- Make sure your tablet's setting is not in airplane mode.
- If you are away from your T-Mobile network, you may need to enable roaming in the tablet's settings to connect to another network. Roaming charges may apply.

My tablet can't connect to the internet

- Make sure that Cellular Data internet service is available in your wireless service plan.
- Check your tablet's settings. Make sure Cellular Data is enabled or Wi-Fi connected.
- Make sure that you are in a place with network coverage for cellular data or Wi-Fi internet connection.
- Try connecting at a later time or from another location.

Invalid SIM card

- Make sure that the SIM card has been correctly inserted (see "Inserting Nano SIM card").
- Make sure that the chip on your SIM card is not damaged.
- Make sure that the service of your SIM card matches the network you're on.

My tablet can't be switched on

- If the tablet can't be switched on, charge for at least 10 minutes to ensure the minimum battery power needed. Then switch it on again.

My tablet has not responded for several minutes

- If your tablet doesn't respond, turn off your tablet by pressing and holding the **Power key** and **Volume up key** until it turns off and then restart it again.

My tablet turns off by itself

- If your tablet turns off by itself, make sure that the Power key is not accidentally pressed.
- Check the battery charge level.
- If it still doesn't work, Factory reset the tablet via the Reset options in the tablet's Settings. Make sure you have backed up your data.

My tablet can't charge properly

- Make sure that you are using the proper charger that comes with the tablet.
- Make sure that your battery is not completely discharged; if the battery power has been discharged for a long time, it may take around 10 minutes to display the battery charging indicator on the screen.
- Make sure that charging is carried out under normal conditions (0°C (32°F) to 45°C (113°F)).

I can't add a contact

- Make sure that your SIM card contact list are not full; delete some files or save the files to the tablet.

I can't send and receive MMS

- Check your tablet storage as it might be full.
- Contact customer care to check service availability and MMS parameters.
- Verify the server center number or your MMS profile with customer care.
- The server center may be swamped. Try again later.
- Start a new Messaging string. Your messaging string may have reached its limit.

SIM card PIN locked

- Contact customer care to obtain the PUK (Personal Unblocking Key) code.

I can't connect my tablet to my computer

- Install Smart Suite.
- Check that your USB driver is installed properly.
- Open the Notification panel to check if the Smart Suite Agent has been activated.
- Check that you have marked the USB debugging checkbox.
- Check that your computer meets the requirements for Smart Suite installation.
- Make sure that you're using the right cable from the box.

I can't download new files

- Make sure that there is enough tablet storage space for your download.
- Select the microSD card as the location to store downloaded files.
- Check your subscription status.

The tablet can't be detected by others via Bluetooth

- Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on and your tablet is visible to other users.
- Make sure that the two devices are within Bluetooth's detection range.

The battery drains too fast

- Make sure that you follow the complete charge time (minimum 3 hours).
- After a partial charge, the battery level indicator may not be exact.
- Wait for at least 10 minutes after removing the charger to obtain an exact indication.
- Adjust the brightness of screen as appropriate.
- Extend the email auto-check interval for as long as possible.
- Update news and weather information manually or increase their auto-check interval.
- Exit background-running applications if they are not being used for extended periods of time.
- Deactivate Bluetooth, Wi-Fi, or GPS when not in use.

The tablet becomes warm following prolonged game playing, internet surfing or running other complex applications

- This heating is a normal consequence of the CPU handling excessive data. Ending the above actions will make your tablet return to normal temperature.

After Factory data reset is performed, I can't use my tablet without entering Google Account credentials

- After reset is performed, you must enter the original Google Account credentials that were used on this tablet.
- If you don't remember your Google Account credentials, complete Google Account recovery procedures.

The tablet doesn't ring when a message arrives

- Make sure that Do Not Disturb mode (go to **Settings > Sound > Do Not Disturb**) is not activated.
- Press the Volume key to adjust volume.
