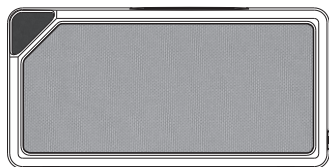
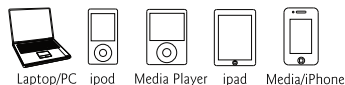


## B81X Bluetooth speaker

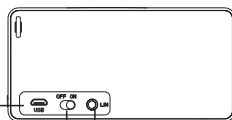
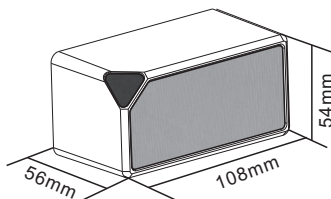

### Product Parameters

- ◇ Input voltage: DC 5V / 2A

### Instructions

#### Play the Music In Bluetooth Speaker Mode:

- ◇ Shift the bluetooth speaker On/Off button to on option to begin the bluetooth speaker mode.
- ◇ Open the bluetooth function on mobile phone to search the bluetooth name" ZTS027" to pair, then begin playing music.

**Line-in Port:** The line interface can be connected to computers, mobile phones and other mobile multimedia devices to play music.
