


Press and hold Multi-Function Button for approximately 8 seconds until red and White LED flash rapidly ; 3) Using your device, please scan/ search for available devices select " S1 " from the list of devices shown; 4) If prompted, enter password or PIN No: "0000" 5) If prompted by your mobile phone to connect, select "Yes"(this will vary among mobile phone models) 6) After successful connecting, White LED of headset will flashes twice every 4 seconds <p>Multi-pairing</p> <p>S1 can connect with two cell phones at the same time. The general pairing procedures are as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Pairing S1 with device A 2) Turn on S1 and make it enter pairing mode again, and pairing it with device B 3) Operate device A to connect with headset.
