



The ultrasonic diffuser uses high frequency ultrasonic technology that vibrates cool water inside the unit creating an ultra fine mist into the air. When oils are added to the water, they are immediately dispersed into the air providing a pleasant fragrance mist.


HOW TO USE

 Carefully remove the glass cover (Fig.1).
 Plug power adapter into the power input of the base. (Fig.2) 3 Use the measuring cup to fill the base with room temperature water (Fig 3)

- 4. Very important to not fill over the max fill line (200 mL) marked in the water tank. 5. Do not use with wax.
- Recommended use distilled, purified, or filtered water
- 7. Add 5-10 drops of oil directly into the water (Fig.3).
- 8. Replace the glass cover onto the base (Fig.4). 9. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet and follow the chart below to operate (Fig.5).

ATTENTION

If the unit is not in use, unplug the unit, drain out the water from the water tank, dry and store in a safe place. The diffuser will auto shut off when the unit is out of water. The diffuser will not work without water.

The amount and intensity of mist produced will vary, but this is not unusual and should not be considered as a fault. Factors that affect this include water type, humidity, temperature and air currents.

We recommend that you clean it every time you change diffuser oils. Oils are corrosive and, over time, they will build up on the diffuser parts.

Store diffuser oils in a cool, dark place with the cap tightly closed and out of the reach of children

Always use caution when handling the glass cover.

MAINTENANCE

After using 5-6 times, or 3-5 days, please clean the product as follows.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

1. Remove battery cover from the bottom/back of the remote by pushing the small tab towards the larger tab while pulling the larger tab out. Replace with 3v CR2025 battery.
 Make sure that the text side of the battery is facing the back of the remote and the bottom of the battery is facing the front of the remote. 4. Slide the battery cover back into the remote until it "clicks" into place.

ACCIDENTAL LEAKAGE

In the event of the unit being knocked over or tipped during use, please follow the instructions below:
1. Unplug the unit from power source and remove water tank cover.
2. Pour out any remaining water out of the water tank.
3. Shake the unit gently to drain any water inside the mechanism, and then allow to dry for at least 24 hours before re-using.

• TROUBLESHOOTING

The product will not turn on. Confirm there is water in the tank and it is not over the max fill line. Confirm the product is connected to the power adapter and that the power adapter is connected correctly to a power outlet.

No mist spray or abnormal mist spray. Confirm there is water in the tank and it is not over the max fill line. Clean the diffuser. (Refer to the maintenance section of this manual.)

The diffuser leaks water. Confirm the glass cover is installed correctly. If the temperature is too low and or the humidity is high, the mist may form water drops.

The remote wont work. Make sure nothing is blocking the remote sensor on the bottom of the diffuser from seeing the remote. Replace the battery with a 3v CR2025 battery and make sure it is installed corectly.
