



T200 Wireless Stereo Headset User Manual

I. Headset overview



II. Charging

- Please charge the T200 at the first time use or when it is under low battery. By doing this, please place the T200 headset in the charging case and connect the case to the power supply with the Micro-USB charging cable attached with the product.
- Micro-USB connector should connect with the power port at the back of the charging case, the USB connector should connect with the USB port of the personal computer or USB charger. Please use the charger that complies with the national electronic code for safety only.
- To fully charge T200 headset requires about 1 hour. When the headset is under charging, the status indicator on the headset will display red light. The red light will be out when the headset is fully charged.
- The case can be charged alone. When it is under the charging mode, the red light on the case will flash. The red light flashes once represents 25% of power, whereas it flashes twice, 3 times and 4 times represent the power charging to 50%, 75% and 100%. When the case is fully charged, the red light will remain on.

III. Pairing T200 headset and the Bluetooth device

T200 headset is equipped with auto-connection function. Please make sure the headset is fully charged in the charging case before use at the first time.

Stereo Mode (Default)

1. Turn off the Bluetooth connection of the mobile phone/devices.
2. Pick up BOTH earbuds at the same time from the charging case; they will automatically turn on (voice prompt: *Power On*) and connecting each other (RIGHT earbud is Host)
3. Turn on the Bluetooth of the mobile phone/devices, and select "T200(R)" from the Bluetooth device list..
4. The pairing is successful a headphone icon appears on your mobile phone status bar (voice prompt: *Connected*)
5. T200 headset will automatically connect to the paired Bluetooth device when it leaves the charging case (wait for about 3-5 seconds).
6. If the headset pairing is not successful, please put it back in the charging case and re-operate the steps 1~4 above.

Single Mode

1. Auto power on : Pick up one of earbuds from the charging case, it will automatically turn on, until the LED indicator flashes red and blue light. Select "T200(R)" or "T200(L)" from the Bluetooth device list.
2. Manually: Press and hold the Multi-function Button on the earbud (any side) until the LED indicator flashes red and blue light. The earbud is ready for connection with the Bluetooth device.

IV. Restore to original settings

T200 headset can be used by stereo or mono mode. If T200 headset can not get in Stereo mode or it has connected to different devices before, it may need to re-setting the Bluetooth pairing.

1. Remove T200 from the Bluetooth device list on mobile phone
2. Pick up BOTH earbuds Hold the Multi-button on the both earbuds over 15 seconds
3. When the earbuds flash blue light 3 times, the headset is restored to the original settings and all memorized Bluetooth devices are eliminated.
4. Remove T200(R) from the Bluetooth device list on your mobile phone/devices.
5. Put the headset back in the charging case, you may pair the Bluetooth connections again (please refer to the description III above)

V. Smart Switch

- Auto power on: Take out T200 headset from the charging case and it will be ready for Bluetooth connection (wait about 3-5 seconds)
- Sleep mode / Power off: When the Bluetooth on the mobile device is turned off and T200 headset does not connect with any other Bluetooth devices, it will automatically turn off in 3 minutes.
- When T200 put back in the charging case, it will get into charging mode and disconnect Bluetooth device.

VI. Multi-function button operation

Button	Functions
Press 1 time	Play / Pause / Answer calls / hand up
Press 2 times	Next track
Press 3 times	Previous track
Press and Hold 2 sec (phone calls)	Reject calls
Press and Hold 2 sec (Power on)	Wake up Siri / Google assistant
Press and Hold 2 sec (Power off)	Manually Tune on
Press and Hold 5 sec (Power on)	Manually Tune off
Press and Hold 15 sec	Restore to original settings

- Please control music volume on the music player.

VII. Headset battery status shown on iPhone/iPad

- When T200 headset is connected to iPhone/iPad via Bluetooth, the battery status of the headset can be displayed on the top of iPhone/ iPad screen after the Bluetooth symbol.
- Please note that the battery status icon may be vertical or horizontal, depending on the Bluetooth device and its operation system.

The way of headset battery status display may vary due to different operation system versions.

- ★ If the headset is not charged for a long time, the Li-ion battery may not be able to preserve the most effective operation. Please fully charge the headset and the charging case once at least every 3 to 6 months to avoid the batteries over discharge that affects the power consumption efficiency.

X. Safety Information
