

Instructions:

- 1. Use a certified USB adapter, connect the
- provided Micro-USB cable to the USB adapter.
- Use Micro-USB tip to connect to the input port on the charging pad.
- Charging mobile devices:
- a. Check your phone or tablet supporting with wireless charging, it will be listed in the manufacturer's specifications.
- b. Simply place the enabled device atop the wireless charging pad. Your device should show the charging indication.
- c. When completely charged, remove the device from the charging pad.
- Note: In order to charge devices, use only the accessory cable or the cable included with your own device by the manufacturer.
