## 1. Getting started

### 1.1 Basic operations

#### 1.1.1 Power on/ off and sleep

1. Connect the device to the TV with HD cable, connect device to the power adaptor, connect mouse, air mouse or other input devices with USB port
2. After the device and cables connected, power LED turns into blue
3. After disconnect the device from the power adaptor, Power LED turns off.
4. Under power on mode, press remote control's power button, device is entering into sleep mode, Power LED turns into red
5. Under sleep mode, device will be wake when you press remote control's power button, power LED turns from red to blue

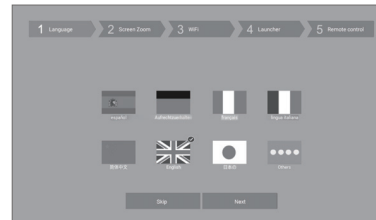
#### 1.1.2 Open applications

Use remote control's arrow keys to choose the wanted program, click OK button to open the selected program

#### Language selection

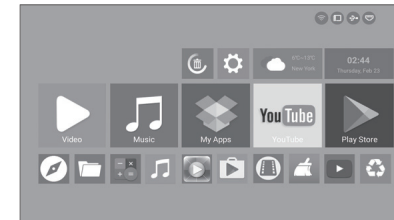


1. Language -- Screen Zoom -- WiFi -- Launcher -- Remote control

Click "My Apps" to view recently used programs, click program icon to switch application arbitrarily



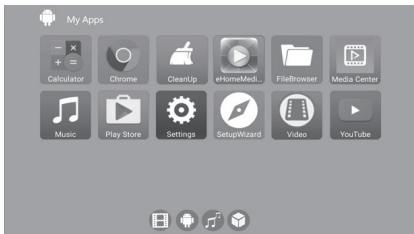
### 1.1.5 Close Applications

You can see icons referring to different function on the picture.



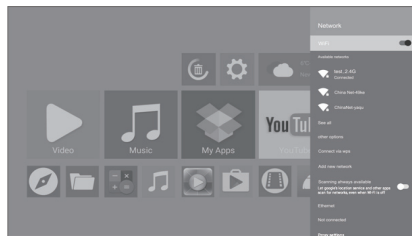
Warm reminder:

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### 1.1.7 WIFI Function

1. Home Screen -- SETTINGS -- Network -- Select "Wi-Fi" to open WIFI function
2. Choose Hotspot -- Input Password -- Connect to the network



### 1.1.8 Ethernet Function

1. Home Screen -- SETTINGS -- Network -- Select "Ethernet" to open Ethernet function
2. Insert network cable, network will be connected automatically

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### 1.1.9 File Browser

Move to "File browser", Press OK to enter into the device list.  
When inserting with USB device or SD/SDHC/MMC cards, the sign "Device is mounting" will be shown on the screen.

Here you can cut, copy, paste and move the files and folder between the local disk and external storage card.



#### Read TF card

Insert TF card into the device in the status of power on, when icon appears in top left corner of the desktop, open "File Browser", the identified External Storage Card will appear under "Local Disk", TF card's operation is available now.

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## 2.1 Troubles hooting

Warning Under no circumstances should you try to repair the TV BOX by yourself, as this will invalidate the warranty. Do not open the TV BOX as there is a risk of electric shock. If a fault occurs, firstly check with points listed below before taking the TV BOX for repair. If you are unable to remedy a problem by following hints, contact your dealer for help.

Problem	Solution
No power	-Check the power adaptor is properly connected to the power and the TV BOX. -Check the power on the remote control to turn on the power.
No picture	-Check the HDMI cable or AV cable. -Check the TV is switched on.
No picture or distorted picture	-Check the setting. -Check the connections are connected correctly.
No audio or digital output	-Check the digital connection. -Check your audio file is not corrupted.
The Player does not respond to the Remote Control	-Adjust the distance to the TV BOX. -Check the batteries in the remote control. -Operations may not be permitted faster to the user manual. -Check the quality of signal linked, reconnect with power adaptor to restart.
Player does not respond to some operating commands (stop, Back)	-The audio codec may not be supported by the TV BOX. You can change to the supported audio on playing menu. -Check the volume.
No sound during movies	-The audio codec may not be supported by the TV BOX. You can change to the supported audio on playing menu. -Check the volume.
The contents of the USB flash drive cannot be read	-The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the box. -If one of the USB can not be read, please turn off the TV BOX for 30 seconds and restart the TV BOX.
Slow operation of the USB	-Use the low or high speed USB flash drive (less longer time to read and write on the USB).
No sound with HDMI connection	-Check the connection between the TV and the HDMI jack of box. -Check the TV system menu. -Check the volume.
No sound with HDMI and the power LED is flashing	-If not sound in HDMI, set the audio output in the system. -If under HDMI status, check if HDMI connection is correct or change another HDMI cable, set the output resolution of the TV BOX into 720p.
