## **1 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

Read these safety instructions before using your device and store them for possible future reference.

- ◆ If the cord is damaged, have it repaired by the manufacturer, its service or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid any hazard.
- ♦ The cord should always be readily accessible.
- ♦ The device is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacity. Persons who have not read the manual, unless they have received explanations by a person responsible for their safety and supervision should not use this unit.
- ♦ Children should be monitored to ensure that they do not play with the device.
- ♦ The device should always be readily accessible.
- ◆ The device should not be exposed to dripping or splashing water.
- ♦ No objects filled with liquids such as vases shall be placed on the device.
- ◆ Always leave a minimum distance of 10 cm around the unit to ensure sufficient ventilation.




## **2 CONTROL FUNCTION**



 Mode select-short press to select mode from Bluetooth, TF card (can't select if TF not insert), FM radio

Press& hold to disconnect the Bluetooth device.

- 2. Power on/off-press & hold to power on/off
- 3. Short press next track/channel Press & hold -volume up
- 4. Built-in mic for hands-free speaking
- 5. Status LED
- Short press previous track/channel Press & hold -volume down
- 7. Short press play/pause, to answer call

- 9. Charging indicator
- 10. Power 5V power socket
- 11. TF card slot

## **4 GET STARTED**

#### **MAINS POWER**

Plug in the USB charging cable (10). The charging indicator will glow red (9) and when the speaker is fully charged, it glows green. Press & hold the power switch (2) to switch on the speaker. The speaker will emit phrase "Bluetooth mode" to confirm it is switched on.

## **AUX (8)**

Connect the speaker to your smartphone, tablet, PC, TV, laptop or games station using an AUX cable with 3.5 mm jack plug.

#### VOLUME CONTROLS

To adjust the volume, press & hold the [volume up] or [volume down] button (3,6) to increase or decrease the volume level. There will be a beep sound to confirm when the volume reaches the maximum.

## TRACK FORWARD/BACK

To select the next or previous track, press the [next track] or [previous track] button (3, 6).

### 5 BLUETOOTH MODE

Note: The term mobile device refers to mobile phones/tablets/MP3 players, laptop or any other devices that was compatible Bluetooth function.

#### HOW TO PAIR WITH THE SPEAKER

Press the button (1) to go into the bluetooth mode. The status LED (5) will flash blue quickly. The speaker is now in pairing mode.

When pairing with a mobile device the speaker will emit a pairing sound. The flashing status LED will turn a fixed blue LED.

When the speaker is powered on it will connect automatically with the last mobile device it was paired to.

#### HOW TO UNPAIR FROM THE SPEAKER

If the speaker is already paired with a mobile device, press and hold Mode button (1) to disconnect. The status LED will flash quickly.

#### PHONE ANSWERING

When your phone is pairing, with an incoming call, short press [answer/cancel call] button (7) to answer the call; press & hold to cancel. Double click to redial the call

# 6 HOW TO GET INTO AUX MODE CONNECTING WITH AN AUX CABLE WITH 3.5 mm JACK PLUG

When an AUX device is plugged in, the speaker will go into the AUX mode automatically. The status LED will flash blue.

Button [volume up/down] available

[previous /next track] [play/pause] not available.

## **7 HOW TO GET INTO TF CARD MODE**

Insert TF card in card slot (11), the speaker will go into TF mode automatically. If TF card has inserted, press [ Mode] button (1) to select TF card mode

## **8 HOW TO GET INTO RADIO MODE**

Press [ Mode] button (1) to select FM radio mode.

## 9 BATTERY POWER

When battery below 20% power, the speaker will emit "Battery Shortage" sound until mains power is connected. It will be powered off automatically to protect the battery if the power reaches a very low level.
