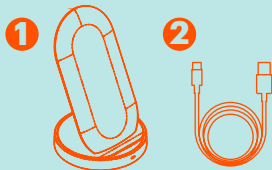

What's in the Box?

Check to make sure you have

1. Wireless Charging Stand
2. Charging Cable



Plug in the wireless charging stand

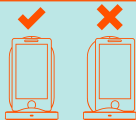

Using the charging cable that came in the box, insert the micro USB plug into the micro USB port on the back of the wireless charging stand. Insert the USB plug into any USB power source, (for example: a wall charger, car charger or computer USB port.)

Place your smartphone onto the stand

Place your Qi-enabled smartphone onto the center of the stand. The charging icon will appear on your smartphone screen to indicate your phone is charging.
