SIMPLE TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEMS, CAUSES & SOLUTIONS
No power - Check and make sure the connecting wires are connected correctly - Check whether the fuse is blown. Replace with the proper value fuse if necessary.
No sound - Check and make sure the speaker wires are connected correctly.
No picture - Check whether the video wire is connected to the video device.
Unit hang-up - Press the RESET button to reset the unit to its default stage.
No function when pressing the buttons or TFT screen - Press the RESET button to reset the unit to its default stage.
Poor effect or unable to receive radio - Check whether the radio antenna is inserted or properly connected. - Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended. - Antenna may be poorly grounded. Check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded.
Stereo cannot be received under radio mode - Tune the radio frequency accurately. - The broadcasting signal is too weak, set the mode to MONO.
Disc inserted but cannot play - Check whether the disc inserted upside down. - Check whether the disc is dirty or badly cracked. - Lens is dirty. Clean lens by using the lens clean disc.
Picture without colour or no sound under disc - Improper setting of colour system. Set again to "PAL", "SECAM" or "NTSC". - The disc is dirty or damaged. Wipe the disc with a dry soft cloth or replace a new disc.
Abnormal moving, skipping or sound during playback - The disc is dirty or damaged. Wipe the disc with a dry soft cloth or replace with a new disc.
Remote handset does not work - Replace new battery of the remote handset. - Point the remote handset directly at the remote sensor of the main unit. - Clean the surface of the remote sensor.
Bluetooth not operated - check the devices are linked up correctly.

Operation & Controls

Power On/Off

When the unit is turned off, press to turn on the unit. When the unit is turned on, press & hold shortly to turn off the unit.

Press repeatedly to select the desired mode for operation.

Note: GPS mode cannot be selected by this control key

Bluetooth Mode (when a mobile phone connected)

Press to hang up or refuse an incoming call.

Remote control sensor (for signal reception from remote handset)

It shows the status of current operation of the unit.

Volume Control

Rotate to adjust sound output level.

Press to turn on or off of sound muting control.

Insert USB device to this slot for digital files playback.

Important: The USB port is intended only for data transfer only, other devices cannot be used with this USB connection. The use of USB extension cords is not recommended.

Insert SD / MMC card to this port for digital files playback.

Insert an external device to this jack in order to have output of the external device through the unit.

Insert or remove disc from this disc slot.

Disc Input Mode

Press to eject disc from the disc slot.

Bluetooth Mode

Press & hold shortly to disconnect the link-up with mobile phone (when a mobile phone has been connected with Bluetooth of the unit).

Radio Mode

Press repeatedly to select the desired radio band for broadcasting.

Disc / USB / SD Input Mode

Press repeatedly to select video system in PAL / NTSC / AUTO mode.

Bluetooth Mode (when a mobile phone connected)

When an incoming call received, press to pick up the call.

Press to dial out after input a phone number.

Press to redial the last dial out number.

Radio Mode – Auto Seek

Press to start automatic seeking frequency upward or downward to the next strong station received for broadcasting.

Press & hold shortly to activate manual tuning mode. At this mode, press repeatedly to tune the radio frequency upward or downward.

Disc / USB / SD / Input Mode – Select Tracks

Press repeatedly to shift track upward or downward for playback.

Each time press & hold shortly to activate various fast forward/rewind speeds for playback.

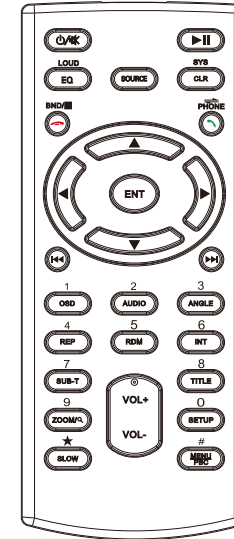

OPERATION & CONTROL MODES

When the unit is turn off, press to turn on the unit.

When the unit is turn on, press & hold shortly to turn off the unit.

During unit operation, press to turn on or off of sound mute control

Press repeatedly to select the desired mode for operation

At Bluetooth mode, press to erase the digit input by error.

Press repeatedly to select the desired preset equalization mode.

Press & hold shortly to turn on or off of loudness control.

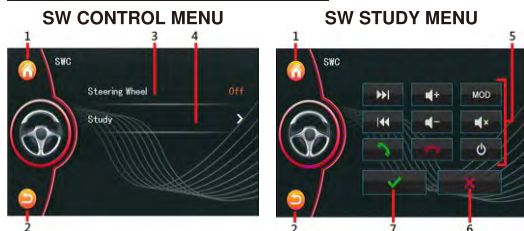
