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


Lift up the back cover to open the battery compartment of the remote control.


Insert two AAA size batteries. Make sure the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries match the (+) and (-) ends indicated in the battery compartment.



Battery Replacement for the Remote Control the Third Step



The remote control sensor on the front unit is sensitive to the remote control's commands up to a maximum of 15' away and within a maximum of a 60 arc.







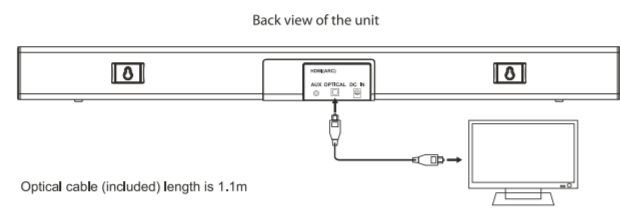
Remote Control Overview

- ⏻ Button switches the unit between ON and STANDBY modes.
- ⏪ Button to reset device to the factory default settings.
- VOL+ button increases the volume.
- ⏮ button skip to previous track in Bluetooth mode.
- VOL- button decreases the volume.
- Press HDMI ARC button, device will play audio from HDMI ARC input.
- Press AUX button, device will play audio from aux input.
- ⏸ button mutes the unit or resumes the sound.
- ⏩ button to play/pause music in Bluetooth mode.
- ⏭ button skip to next track in Bluetooth mode.
- Press EQ button to select music, movie and talk EQ mode.
- Press OPTICAL button, device will play audio from optical input.
- Bluetooth Connection switches to Bluetooth mode, press and hold to enable Bluetooth pairing. If there is an existing connection then disconnect the devices, unit will enter pairing mode.

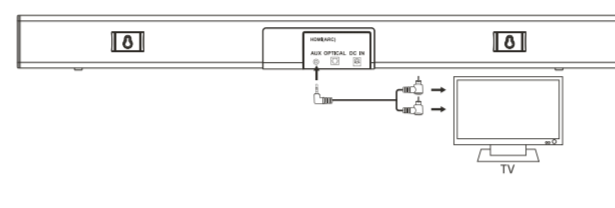
Use an optical cable (included) to connect the TV's OPTICAL OUT Port to the soundbar's OPTICAL Port.



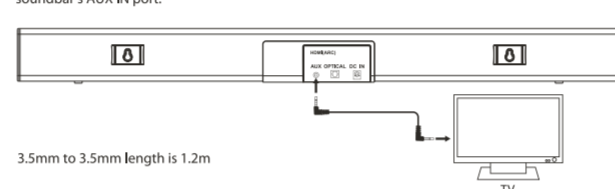

Use a 3.5m RCA stereo audio cable (not included) to connect the TV's audio output Port to the soundbar's AUX IN port.



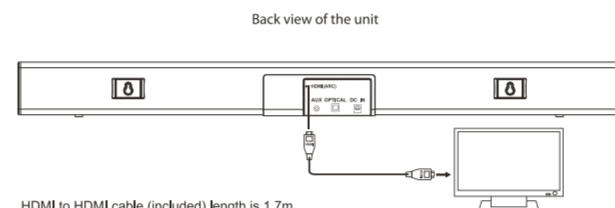
Use a 3.5m stereo audio cable (included) to connect the TV's headphone Port to the soundbar's AUX IN port.

Using the HDMI Connection

Use a HDMI to HDMI cable (included) to connect the TV's HDMI(ARC) port to the soundbar's HDMI(ARC) port. Please note that the soundbar has HDMI CEC function.



HDMI to HDMI cable (included) length is 1.7m

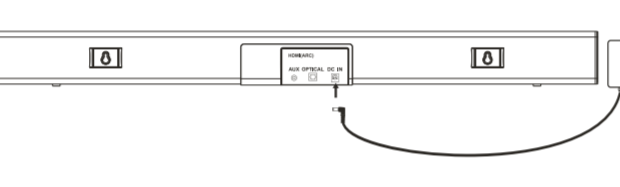
Using the Bluetooth Connection

- Turn on the power, press () on the unit or remote control to switch the unit to ON mode with a prompt tone.
- Keep the distance of the soundbar and your mobile phone, PC tablet or other Bluetooth enabled device within 1 meter. The closer, the better.
- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and that your device is discoverable.
- Select the Bluetooth mode on the soundbar:
Using the remote control, press the Bluetooth button. The indicator light on the soundbar will be flashing blue.
Alternatively, press the source button on the soundbar until the indicator light is flashing blue.
- Select the Bluetooth search function on your device. Your device should discover the soundbar which is called "Onn 30P 2.1 soundbar".
- Select pairing mode:
Using the remote control, press and hold the Bluetooth button for 3 seconds until blue indicator light is flashing slowly.
Alternatively, press and hold the source button on the soundbar for 3 seconds until the blue indicator light is flashing slowly.
- Select the Bluetooth search function on your device. Your device should discover the soundbar which is called "Onn 30P 2.1 soundbar".
- Select "Onn 30P 2.1 soundbar" your device is paired with the soundbar when the blue indicator light stops flashing and becomes solid.



Connecting to the Power Outlet

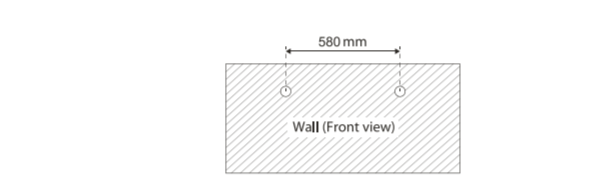
- This unit is designed to operate with the provided adapter.
- Connecting the unit to any other power source may damage the unit. Unwind the adapter cable to its full length. Connect the end of the cable to the DC IN Port at the back of the unit and then connect the adapter to the outlet. Make sure the adapter is firmly inserted into the outlet. The unit is now connected and ready to use.
- Switch the unit off completely, unplug the adapter from the outlet.



Ensure all audio connections of the unit are connected before connecting to the main power outlet.

Product Wall Mounting the First Step 01

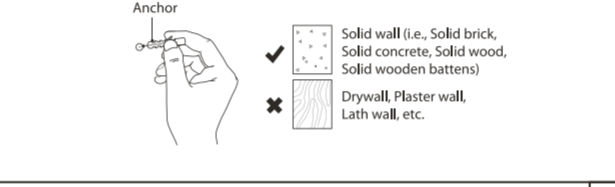
1. Drill 2 parallel holes (Ø 8mm each according to wall type) in the wall. The distance between the holes should be 60mm.



- Installation must be carried out by qualified personnel only. Incorrect assembly can result in severe personal injury and property damage if you intend to install this product yourself; you must check for installations such as electrical wiring and plumbing that may be buried inside the wall. It is the installer's responsibility to verify that the wall will safely support the total load of the Soundbar.

 - Use an electronic stud finder to check the wall type before drilling and mounting.

2. Firmly fix 1x dowel D10x2130mm (not included) into each hole in the wall if necessary.

3. Insert 1 screw TA 4*40mm (not included) into each anchor. Be sure to leave a firm grip between the wall and the screw's head. Lift the unit over the heads of the screws and slot into place.

Hints and Tips

- If a problem occurs, it may often be due to something very minor. The following table contains various tips.
- When switching to another channel, the Bluetooth will be in disconnected status.
 - When LED indicator is flashing blue, the Bluetooth will be paired and be in disconnected status.
 - When LED indicator becomes solid, the Bluetooth will be reconnected successfully with connection.
- Problem Solution
 - No power
 - Check the mains socket is connected correctly and both ends.
 - Make sure that the ON mode is selected.
 - The remote control is not functioning
 - Use the remote control near the unit.
 - Point the remote control at the remote sensor on the unit.
 - Replace the battery in the remote control with a new one.
 - Remove any obstacles between the remote control and the unit.
 - Loud hum or noise in sound
 - The plug and sockets are dry. Wipe them with a damp cloth.
 - Use a plug and sockets with an appropriate non-obscure cleaning solution.
- If any functions obviously is encountered, unplug the unit from the mains outlet and reconnect it again.
