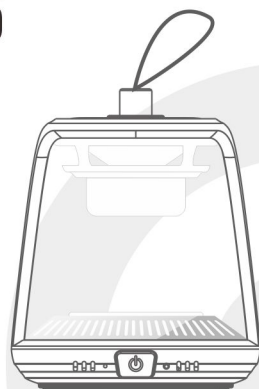


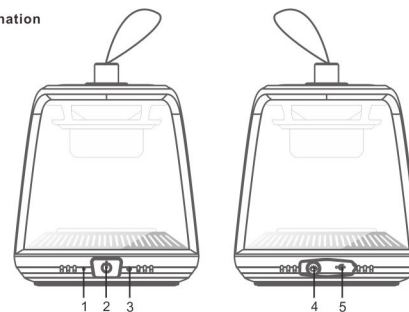

Bluetooth Speaker

G5



A. Key definition



1. **Mic**: Microphone for Hands-free calling
2. **Power button**: Long press and hold for 2 seconds to turn on the device, automatically enter into Bluetooth searching, and the blue light flash, hear voice "Bluetooth device is ready to pair". The Bluetooth light will stop flash and keep stable after pair and connect another device by Bluetooth. Short press to pick up the phone when have coming call, and short press again to end up the call.
3. **Lithium battery power display**
4. **Mood light button**: Short press to turn on/off the mood light.
5. **TWS**: Long press the mood light button of two G5 speakers at the same time, the two G5 will pair as TWS Speakers
5. **DC 5V Power supply**

B. Input/Output

1. DC 5V Power supply
2. Built in Li-polymer battery 800mAh
3. Power output: 5W

C. Charging use

Lithium Battery charging: The light is bright in red after the USB cable is inserted for charging, and the red light turns green after the Lithium Battery is charged to full.
