Notes of Importance

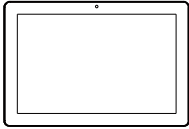
- 1)The unit is for indoor use only.

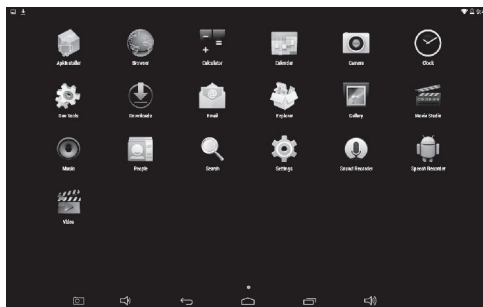

Android OS Home Screen


- 1) Insert the power lead into the DC socket, and then insert the other end into the power socket.
- 2) The unit will automatically power on.
- 3) Screen will show the starting logo.
- 4) Wait for about 25 seconds and enter into main interface.

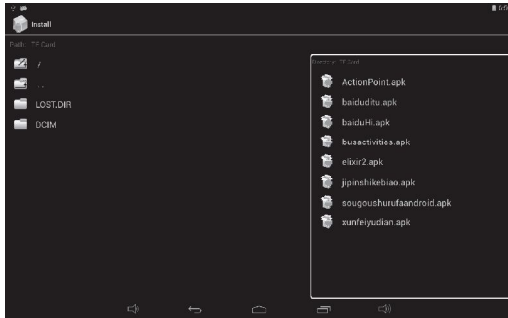


- 5) In the main menu click  icon to go to APPS menu screen.

- 7) Click the apps icon to enter into apps click the "RETURN" icon, return to previous page click the "HOME" icon return to the main menu.

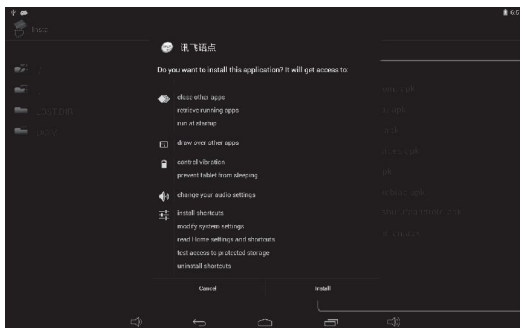


Install APP
