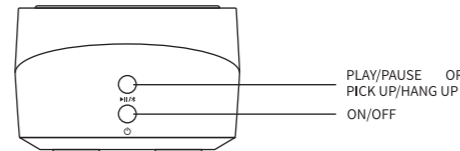
## PRECAUTIONS

## COMMON FUNCTIONS

Different status of speaker are:

- 1.1 STANDBY
- 1.2 BT PAIRING
- 1.3 BT RECONNECT
- 1.4 BT CONNECTED (STREAMING)
- 1.5 BT CALLING

Operation as below:

Buttons:

- 2.1 When the speaker is off, long press the POWER button for two seconds to turn on (other operations are invalid). When the speaker is on, long press POWER button for two seconds to turn on (standby power consumption is less than 100uA)
- 2.2 Automatically starts for pairing after turned on, it also has reconnection function.
- 2.3 Connected status, click PLAY button to play/pause.
- 2.4 Connected status, long press BT button for three seconds to disconnect the current connection and enter to pairing status,
- 2.5 Incoming call status, click the PLAY button to answer, long press PLAY button to reject.
- 2.6 During the call, click PLAY button to hang up, long press PLAY button to switch between mobile phone and speaker.
- 2.7 Long press PLAY button for 10 seconds to restore to default setting.
- 2.8 Third party calls are not supported.

LED light:

- 3.1 In standby mode, all LED lights are off.
- 3.2 Blue LED light flashes quickly in pairing mode or reconnection status.
- 3.3 Blue LED light is on while BT is connected.
- 3.4 Blue LED light flashes slowly in BT playing status.
- 3.5 When the speaker is charging, its red light will turn on, and the red light will go off if charging completed.
- 3.5 The wireless charging part is illuminated by red light when plugged into USB, when it detects that there is no chargeable device, the power automatically switches to charge the speaker. When an external chargeable device is detected, it lights up in green and automatically starts charging.

## CHARGING EXPLANATION

1. You need to plug in the USB to wirelessly charge mobile phone
2. After plugging in USB, if no chargeable device is detected, it will automatically charge to the speaker

## HINT TONE

1. They are: power on, power off, disconnected, connected, incoming call ringtone etc.
2. The incoming call ringtone volume defaults to 80%

## BT PROTOCOL AND COMPATIBILITY

BT V4.2 includes: A2DP、HFP、AVRCP. Support mobile phones, tablet PCs and most of the BT devices.

## COMMON PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS

PHENOMENON PROBLEM	SOLUTIONS
Fail to connect for several times	1. Check if the speaker is in search status, or reboot 2. Many BT devices is around causing search difficulties, turn off the other BT devices.
Low sound or distorted sound	1. Check the volume of BT device, then adjust it to appropriate place 2. Low battery, please charge in time.
Intermittent sound	Check whether beyond the effective connection distance of speaker, or obstacles between speaker and BT device.
BT status light does not work	1. Indicates low battery, please fully charge then try again. 2. Reboot the speaker.
