How to wear








How to take out


Open the Charging Case approximately 90 degrees, then get the earbuds vertically











How to pair

Support Bluetooth V2.1+EDR or above version devices connection

Use both the left and right earbuds at the same time

1. Open the Charging Case (The earbuds is in the case)

2.Turn on the phone bluetooth function and search for "V80", the click to connect "V80", after pairing successfully, then you can get the earbuds out to use

Use single earbud

- 1.Take only one earbud,(left one or right one), then close the
- 2. The blue light on earbud will light up, then you can triple-clicks the function button until the earbuds light become the mode of "red light and blue light alternately flashes", then it starts to pair
- 3. Turn on the phone bluetooth function and search for "V80", the click to connect "V80", you can pair single earbud at this time.

Subsequent Use

After first using, the earbuds (The earbuds is in the charging case) will pair to your phone automatically as long as you open the charging case for later use (please make sure that you turn on the phone's bluetooth function)

Earbuds Pairing

Port

- When you fail to pair the earbuds the first time, please take the left and right earbuds out of the charging case at the same time, click the function button twice until one of the earbud show "red light and blue light alternately flashes", which means that the earbuds pair successfully, then turn the phone's bluetooth function and search for "V80", click to connect "V80", both the earbuds will work.

Function Button

Working Status:

•Press the function button for 5 seconds,

you will hear the voice " turn off"

Answer the phone by short time pressing while calling, as well as end up the calling by short time pressing
 Press the function button for 2 seconds until "DO DO" voice, you can refuse to answer the calling

Click the function button 3 times until " DO DO" Voice, you can turn on " Siri"function.

DO" Voice, you can turn on " Siri"function.
 While listening the music, press to Pause/Play music

Double-Click the multi-function button, you can recall the latest phone call while in standby mode.

Next song: Press the right earbud multi-function button for 2 seconds
 Increase volume: Twice-click the right earphone button



Previous song: Press the left earbud multi-function button for 2 seconds
Reduce Volume: Twice-click the left earphone button

*When you turn off one earbud while both two working, the left one can still work without interrupting.

*Support Turn on/Turn off the earphone, press the multi-function button for 3 seconds to turn on, press the multi-function button for 5 seconds to turn off.

Earbuds Charging

Both the earbuds and charging case own bulit-in Battery, please don't disassemble. Please make sure the earbuds are fully charged while first using

Charging Case Charging:

Charge the Case: Use the Type C cable to charge the case. Plug
 the cable to USB BV Output. All the 4 power
 indicator light alternately flashes while charging

 Full Charge Status: When all the 4 lights are lightening at the same time, it indicates that the case is fully charged, please unplug the cable from the power outlet.

Power insufficient status: If the case power is insufficient, the The left-most light of the 4 lights is flashing.

Earbud Charging:

Charge the earbuds: Put both the left and right earbud into the charging case, both the left and right indicator lights show red light, which means they are under charged status (The charging case indicator lights is always on work)

Full Charge Status: When the left and right earbud are fully charged, both the indicator light will go out , and the charging case will automatically power off.

Power insufficient Status: When the earbuds power is insufficient, it will send a sound interval "Your battery is running low, please get item charged", and the indicator red light alternately flashes. If they are powered off while calling, the phone call will automatically transferred to your phone.

Automatically turn off	Earbuds power is insufficient	Charge the earbuds
Hear Noises	The outside interruption or too far away from your phone	Please go to another place without interruption or get close to your phone
Interrupted Signal	The outside interruption or too far away from your phone	Please go to another place without interruption or get close to your phone
Can't hear via single Earbud	Didn't pair successfully	Please refer to " Earbuds Pairing "steps
