



### How to pair

Support Bluetooth V5.0 or above version devices connection

Use both the left and right earbuds at the same time Auto Pairing
1.0pen the Charging Case (The earbuds is in the case)
2.Turn on the phone bluetooth function and search for "V90", the click to connect "V90", after pairing successfully, then you can get the earbuds out to use

- Use single earbud.

  1. Take only one earbud, (left one or right one), then close the charging case.

# Earbuds Pairing

When you fail to pair the earbuds the first time, please take the left and right earbuds out of the charging case at the same time, click the function button twice until one of the earbud show "red light an blue light alternately flashes", which means that the earbuds pair use cassfully, then turn the phone is bluetooth function and search for '90°, click to connect' '90°, both the earbuds will work.
