4 CONFIGURATION OF PORTS

(Note: For your information, Here is to R1 only, there could be no F and G ports of some R series)

The machine has many ports of audio source input except for Phono , it is able to connect with external speakers and headphone output.

5 KEY FUNCTION

Please turn function knob C to the left or right to adjust the volume.


Please turn function knob "D" to the left is to choose outputs of audio sources, which are (internal speakers), RCA (fomer speakers), (external speakers) (headphone) in order. The default output is internal speakers.


And turn function knob "D" to the right is to choose inputs of audio sources, which is **PHONO** (Vinyl), **AUX** (Auxiliary Audio), **BT** (Bluetooth), **USB** (USB Audio) and **FM** (Radio) in order.


Note: the R2 has no ♠ (external speaker output)

Please turn function knob "E" to the left or to the right is to choose previous or next song when playing mode in BT or USB . And turn function knob E to the left or to the right is to choose rpm to 33 1/3 or 45 when playing mode in <code>PHONO</code>.

Note: when you see 33 on the screen, it means the speed is 33 1/3.







6 CONNECT WITH EXTERNAL SPEAKERS

(Note: the following diagram form is only for R1, the R2 & R3 have no such function.)

Relabel:

L+/L- stands for Plus-n-Minus of the left channel.

R+/R- stands for Plus-n-Minus of the right channel.

Please connect the loud speakers according to the label of ports. Then operate the device with all the cables checked.


For different types of jacks, please take a reference to the right diagram. If you use a pair of bare wires, it is better that the length of exposed parts is less than 1cm.

7 CONNECT WITH OTHER SOUND EQUIPMENT


1. If you have any other sound equipment, you can connect it to "RCA" input with a RCA cable.




8 PLAY VINYL RECORD

Before using unit to play Phono, please read the warning instruction of turntable carefully.

1. Open the box and laid the machine on a horizontal table and please read the installation instruction of the turntable carefully.





2. Connect the attached power adaptor and turn it on.




3. Rotate the function knob D to the right or press the "mode" button on the remote till you see **PHONO** on the screen.

⁴ Put the record onto turntable with both hands on the edge of it. Please do not leave any fingerprints or smudge on it so as to get good playing affect.









5. Please make sure that the tonearm lifter is on the position of up 90 degrees before removing the tonearm. Otherwise It is necessary to put the lifter up 90 degrees for sure. And then you can take the cover of cartridge off.

7. Hold the lifter of pickup with thumb and forefinger lightly and move it on top of record edge.




Note: the cartridge is a precision components and please operate it carefully. Do not move it freely during playing as to avoid breaking the stylus.

Note: It is necessary for you to take the cover of pickup off before using the unit. And do not touch the end of stylus in order to protect it from any damage.



8. Put the tonearm lifter down to the edge of a record slowly.


9. If you need to stop playing music or change another record, put the lifter up first, then hold the lifter of tonearm with thumb and forefinger and move it horizontally, finally put it down to the cliprrdrscuffr.And the whole process is shown in the figure as below.



10. Rotate the function knob E when it was in **PHONO** mode, choosing the speed 33 1/3 or 45 to the right.


The default rpm is 33 1/3 and please adjust the specific speed according to the label of your record.

11. Have a left rotation to the function knob "E" and control the motor switch of turntable.




9 PLAY WIRELESS MUSIC

1. To turn the function knob "D" to the right or press the "mode" button on the remote, then choosing the channel BT while ti is in flicker unconnected state; Here you can use your mobile phone or other music players to search R1, R2, R3 and you can enjoy your music then.(when the BT indicator blink, it means the unit does not match with other system. Vice versa.




10 PLAY CABLE MUSIC

1. Connecting the output port of the machine on the back with AUX cable (3.5mm). Then moving the function knob D to the right or press the "mode" button of the remote until "AUX" on the screen.




Note: When playing cable music only the players itself can choose the song however remote does not.




11 PLAY USB MUSIC

1. Plug a USB flashdisk with music files into the machine first; and turn the function knob "D" to the right or press the "mode "button of the remote till "USB" on the screen. And the machine will play the music automatically.




2. To turn function knob "E" to the left or to the right is to choose previous or next song. The functions can also be done by remote control.



12 LISTEN TO THE RADIO


1. Insert the complimentary FM antenna/AUX cable first, then turn the function knob "D" to the right or press the "mode" button of the remote till you see FM on the screen.

(To avoid any electromagnetic interference, please keep the "FM" antenna far away from large power-consuming equipment like power socket, induction cooker etc.)




2. A long turning function knob "E" to the left or to the right is to search radio automatically;


A short turning is to choose the previous radio or next one, and also you can do itwith your remote control.




13 USE THE HEADPHONE

1. Turn the function knob "D" to the left after plugging the headphone into the machine, and then choose the label of \bigcap headphone output.

SAFTY INSTRUCTION

About safety

- 1. The machine should be operated only from the the type of power source in your area.
- 2. If any solid or liquid substance falls into the housing, the power should be unplugged and checked by professional technicians.
- 3. Turn off the device and unplug the power cord if you do not intend to use this unit for a long time. Please unplug the adapter from the socket to disconnect the power cord but never pull the power cord only.

About repackage

Keep all packing materials for future use.

BELT REPLACEMENT

According to the using situation, the rotating belt will wear and even break and the rotating belt should be replaced at this time. The specific methods are as follows:

- 1. Turn off the machine and other equipment, then unplug the power cord.
- 2. Remove the platter and you will see a wheel and a belt.
- 3. Remove the belt from the wheel and motor.
- 4. Wrap the new belt around the wheel and motor. And the belt will not kink.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Please use soft dry cloth to clean the device and do not move it when it works. If there are any stains that can not be removed, please wet you cloth with neutral detergent. And do not use any chemicals such as alcohol, gasoline, paint thinner.

The LP audio system is a precise instrument. In order to protect it from any damages, do not move the stylus before putting it up with lifter or when the unit is working. Otherwise it will cause permanent damage to the stylus or record.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience a problem with this machine, please check the following items before requesting service:

1. When the tonearm slide out or stay on the same track,

place the device on a flat table to ensure the turntable is in a level surface.

There is dust or scratches on the record.

Please wipe the surface with the cleaning product or change the record.

2. Sound distortion

Once the stylus is dirty, please wipe it with cleaning product; And if the stylus is worn we'd suggest to get in touch with our after-sales dept and change it.

And you can also connect our after-sales dept to replace the belt when it is worn.

There is dust or stains on the record. Please wipe the surface with the cleaning product

There are scratches on the record. Please change the record and replay.

Check whether the speed is normal or not.

3. Hum or rumble in low frequency

The device may close to the speakers or there is magnetic interference.

4. No rotation

Please check the power cable connection and whether it's power on.

Make sure the belt is wrapped around the wheel and motor completely.

5. Stereo image is not good

Signal input cables or speaker cables are wrong connected. Please reconnect it as suggested in the manual.

6. Dysfunction or no reaction of the remote control

Disturbed by external devices; Keep away from the disturbance and restart then.

Batteries of the remote control are low; Please replace them with new ones.

Obstacle is located between the remote control and the unit . Please move the object.


