

Getting Started

★ Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the USB cable into the USB charging port on the end of the stick. Plug the other end into the USB port on your computer, a USB charging device, or a **5V USB charging adapter** (not included) and plug into a wall socket.

The LED indicator will turn RED while charging and turn off when full charged.

On low power, a tone will be periodically heard, indicating that the speaker should be charged.
