

Battery Recharge

- Connect the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB port of any computer or USB charger having DC 5V output. (During charging, the Red Indicator on the unit will illuminate. When finished, it will turned off)




Notes:

OPERATION

In first time use or re-pairing to new BT Device, pairing the unit to external BT Device as below:

- 1. Long press switch button for 3 seconds. Blue Indicators will light and blinking.
- 2. Power on the external BT Device and enter to searching mode. Start pairing as the on screen instructions on the external BT Device. After paired, the Blue Indicator will stop blinking. (For

details pairing procedures, please refer to the user's manual of your BT Device).

- 3. When the Bluetooth connected success, the default mode is music+led light.
- 4. Long Press the "M" Button to turn Off the decorative light. Press again to turn it On. Short press to change the LED light mode, the LED light with 5 ways shining mode, and the color changing lights pulsate to the beat.

Notes:

- When the external BT player searched the unit, our model number "HXWW502JD" will appear on the display of external BT Device.
- Pairing code"0000" or "1234" may need to enter.

Normal operation after pairing:

- 1. Power on the unit as previous procedures.
- 2. Wait a few seconds until the unit was auto paired to the external BT Device. "Bluetooth connected" will heard from speaker.
- 3. Plays the music in the connected Bluetooth Device as usual.
