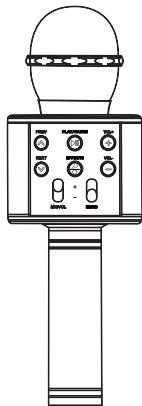



•INSTRUCTIONS

Connect Bluetooth

- 1.Press the  button and hold for 3 seconds to turn on/off the microphone.
- 2.When the device is turned on, it will stay ready to pair mode.
- 3.Turn on the bluetooth on your smart phone/tablet or computer.
- 4.Search Bluetooth settings for " iTech Mic "








Adjust Volume

- 1.Adjust the music volume by "VOL+ VOL-"
- 2.Long press the "Effects" button to bend your voice with 4 different effects.
- 3.Adjust microphone volume by "MIC VOL"
- 4.Add reverb to your voice by adjust the "ECHO" button.

Play music with TF or Micro SD card

- 1.Insert a USB drive with SD card or TF card into the device.
- 2.Microphone will be switched automatically to TF or Micro SD card mode.

•DEVICE FUNCTIONS

1. "  " Hold: Turn on / off
Click: Switch Mode between TF/SD/Bluetooth
2. "  " Click: The previous song
3. "  " Click: The next song
4. "  " Click: Play / Pause
5. "  " Click: Mic mode(Mute the vocal part when playing music)
Hold: Bend your voice with 4 different effects
6. "  " Increase volume
7. "  " Decrease volume
