## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Fully charge your device before using.

POWER ON Remove the earbuds from the charging case to power on each earbud. When both earbuds are on, they will automatically pair to each other within a couple of seconds. POWER OFF Insert the earbuds into the charging case

to shut down. You can also long-press the touchpad for 5 seconds to power them off. The light will flash red to indicate that they are powering off. **BLUETOOTH PAIRING** The earbuds will pair to each

other (left and right) automatically. When paired to each other, the left Earbud will flash blue and the right earbud will continue to flash red and blue to indicate that the earbuds are ready to pair with a device.

Make sure your device's Bluetooth settings are turned on. The earbuds will appear as iTouch Amp Plus in

your device list. Select iTouch Amp Plus to pair with your device. **USING YOUR EARBUDS** 

Control the earbuds by using the earbud touchpads:

- · Tap: play/pause, answer/hang up · Double click (L): Restart Track or go to
