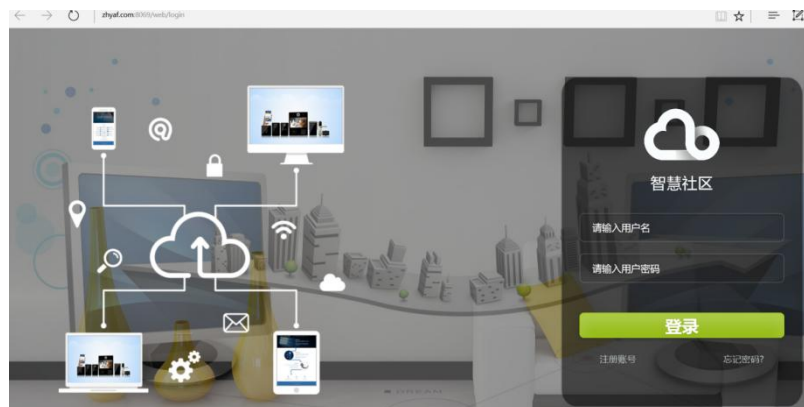

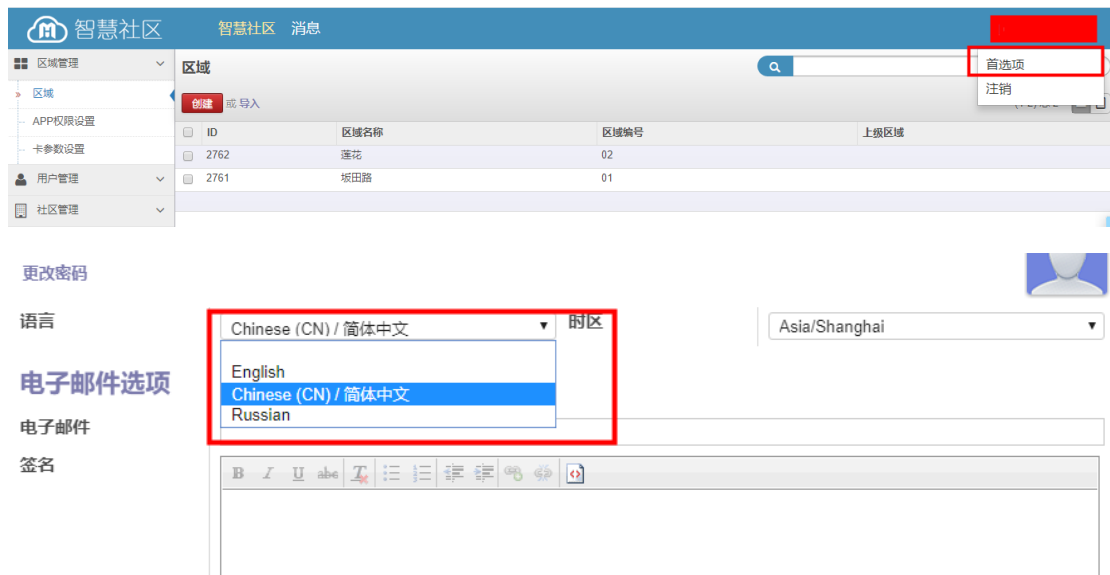


2 , Log in [www.thinmoo.com](http://www.thinmoo.com), register the background management account, and enter the operation page of the background system of the Smart community after logging in the account.



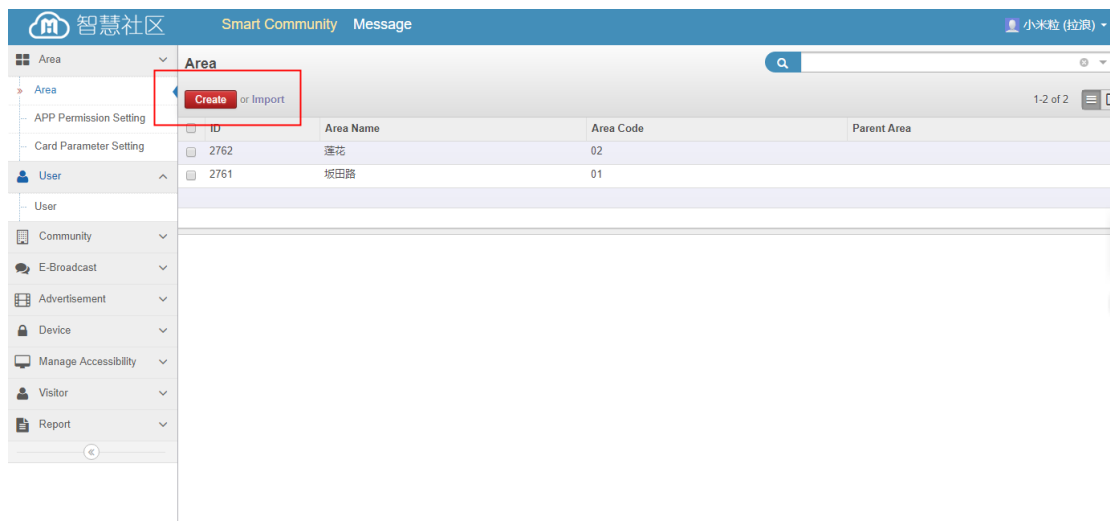
## 2、 Language Settings

Click the user name in the upper right corner to set the language:



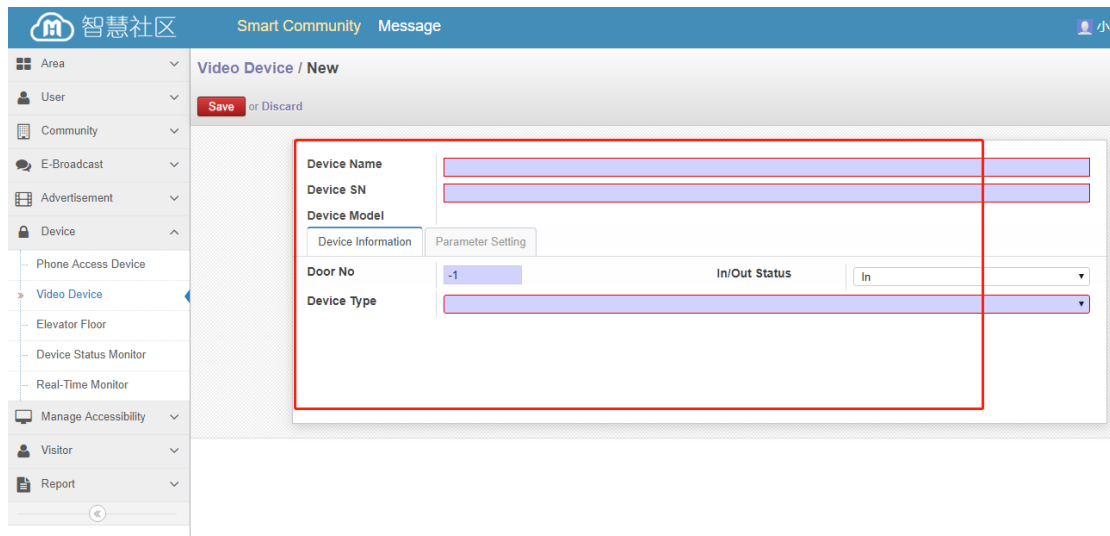
### 3、User creation ( Note: Blue box is a mandatory option )

1 , Click the user management on the left side to create a user, and fill in three names, APP account and the area to which the user belongs. The name can be filled in the name of the residential area or the name of the person.

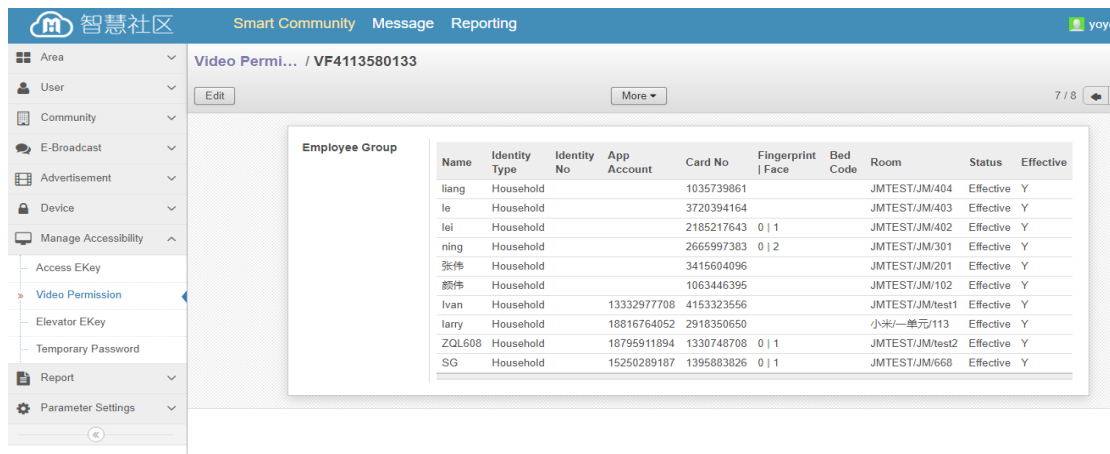


### 4 、 Equipment management and access control management

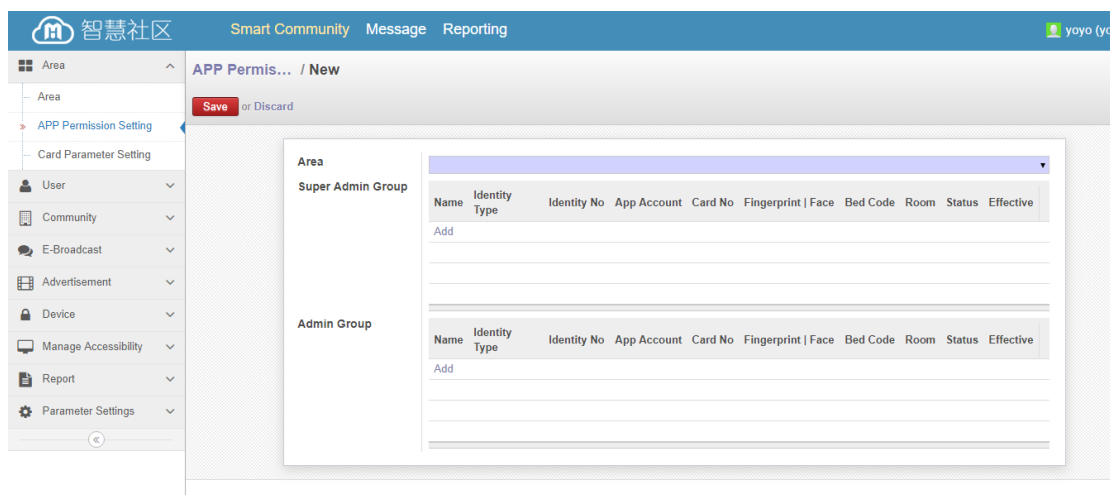

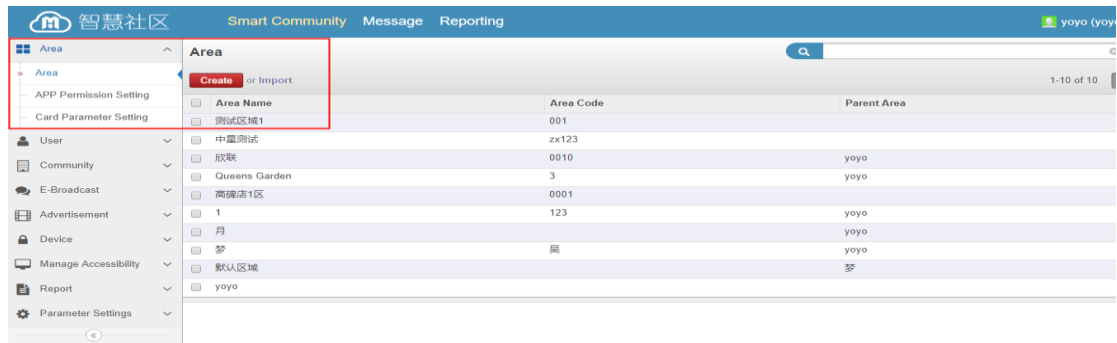


2 , Administrator permission setting.

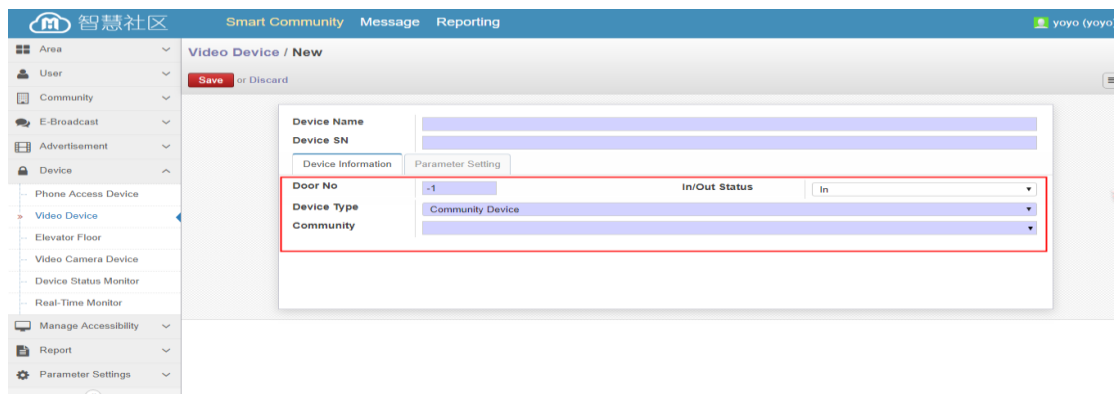


## 5、 Export and import of card data

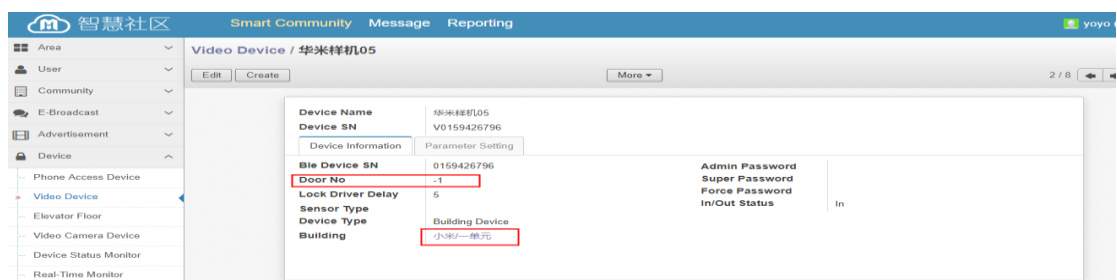
### 1. Create the corresponding region.



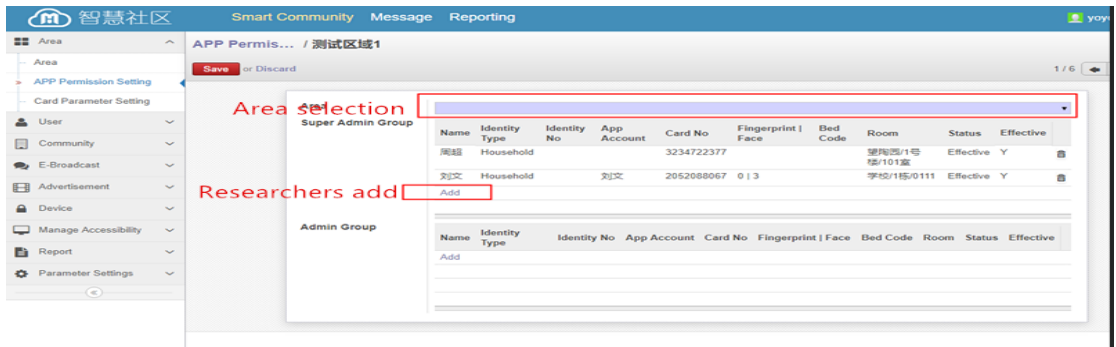
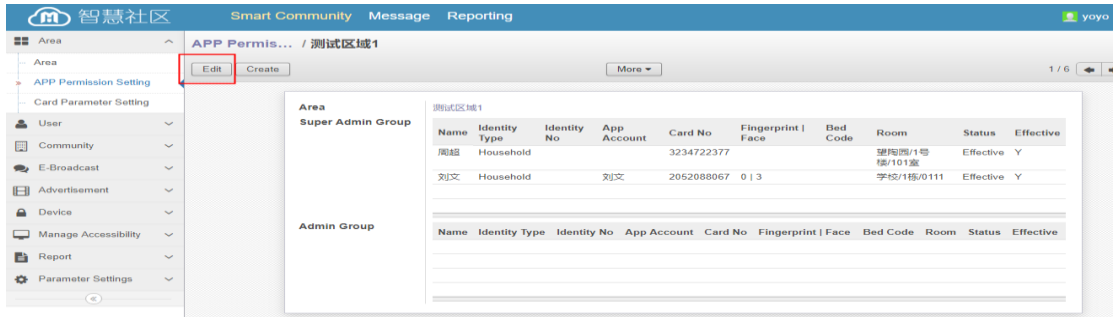
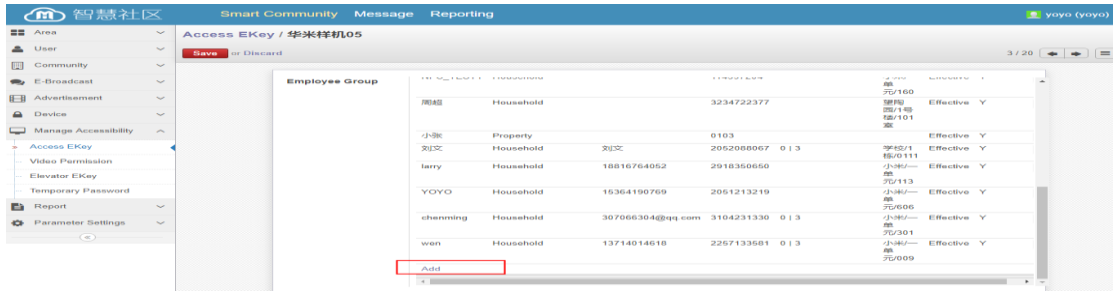
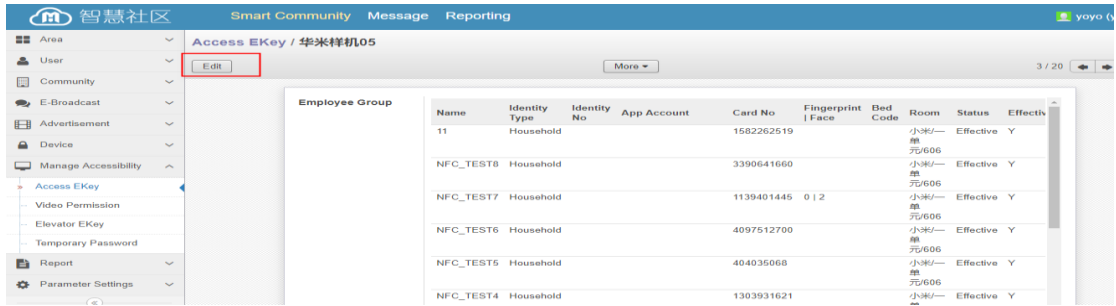
### 2. When creating the device, number the device and set the area.
