Powering the device

Using the provided USB Type-C Cable, connect the Type-C connector to the Type-C Input on the speaker, and the Standard USB Connector to a 5V 3A(Or higher) Power Plug/Adaptor *.

*Note: Please make sure to use a 5V 3A (or higher Ampere/Current Power Plug) to power the device. Using a 2A or lower current power plug may result in wireless charge malfunction especially when the wireless charge function and speaker function and speaker function and the device are used at the same time.

• Power On/Off & Switch modes

Press and hold the <code>[O]</code> button to turn on the speaker. Short press the <code>I</code> $^{M_{BSS}}_{BSS}$ button to switch modes. Short press the <code>[O]</code> button to enter clock mode. Short press the <code>[O]</code> button in clock mode to switch back to other modes again.

Wireless Charge your mobile device

Place your mobile device on the rubber ring of the powered WD-300. Look for the wireless charge icon [\bigcirc] 1 and make sure the wireless charge area on your mobile device is right on top of the wireless charge icon [\bigcirc] 1. Adjust the position of your mobile device if charging is

Bluetooth Pairing

Press the $I \stackrel{f.}{\Longrightarrow} I$ button repeatedly to enter Patring mode. The word FBLUE* will start blinking on the speaker indication that it is waiting for device to pair. On your Bluetooth device, find and select *UN-300 / who will be pair. A successful connection via bluetooth will be followed by an audible on ortification. For hele with Bluetooth Settinos allowed so was a device super manual.

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• Handsfree Speakerphone

The handsfree speakerphone function is enabled when the device is paired with your mobile device. Prest in $\{ E_i B_i \}$ knot to answer an incoming call. To decline a call without answering, press and hold the $\{ E_i B_i \}$ knot during an incoming call. To a decline a call write the $\{ E_i B_i \}$ knot during a call. For the best conversation experience, make sure the WD-300 unit is placed near further during the users.

• FM Radio

Press the $\left[\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{800} \right]$ button repeatedly to enter FM radio mode. Press and hold the $\left[\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{800} \right]$ knob to initial automatic channel search. Searched channels will be saved automatically Press the $\left[\begin{array}{c} 4 \\ 1 \\ 0 \end{array}\right]$ button to switch channels. Short press the $\left[\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{800} \right]$ k nob to mute the speaker when listening to the radio and short press the button again to unmute.

Note 1: When using FM Radio mode, please plug in the provided AUX cable to the AUX Jack on the device. The cable acts as an external antenna for radio reception. You can adjust the position of the cable for better radio reception.

Note 2: Wireless charger function can interfere with the radio signals.

• TF Card

Insert a TF card to enter TF card mode or press the [Mass] button to switch to TF card mode if card is already inserted Press the [4] or [▶] button to select music from the card. Press the [★III] knob to play/pause music.

· Auxiliary Connectin (AUX)

Use the provided AUX cable, connect one end to the AUX Out jack of your audio source device and the other end to the AUX in jack on the WD-300 device. Press the $\begin{bmatrix} \mathbb{R} \\ \mathbb{B} \mathbb{R} \end{bmatrix}$, button to switch AUX mode. Press the $\begin{bmatrix} \mathbb{R} \\ \mathbb{R} \end{bmatrix}$, knob to mute/unmute the speaker.

Setting the close

• Snooze/Alarm Dimiss & Alarm On/Off

The alarm will still buzz on the next day. To disable the alarm completely, press and hold the I ○ 1 button until the white dot next to the clock digits disappear.

Soothing Mode/ White noise mode

Press the 【 ♣ 1 button to switch to Soothing mode. Press the 【 ◀ 】

or 【 ▶ 】 button to select soothing sounds. Press the 【 ₱ 20 】 knob to play/pause soothing sound. Soothing sound/music will automatically stops if the speaker has not been operated for 30 mins.
