1.3 MPE Calculation Method

 $S = (30*P*G) / (377*R^2)$

- S = power density (in appropriate units, e.g., mw/cm²)
- P = power input to the antenna (in appropriate units, e.g., mw)

the power gain factor is normally numeric gain.
