Installation


Install the dashcam behind the rear view mirror. Remove any fringe mirror and clean dry the windshield before installation.

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Calibrate Date/Time

DC21 is a built-in feature that allows you to set the date and time. To use this feature, you need to connect the dashcam to your smartphone via WiFi.



- Go to your smartphone's settings and connect to the dashcam's WiFi network.
- Open the Dashcam app and tap on the "Calibrate Date/Time" option.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to set the date and time.

Photo Size — 4K@30FPS

2. Turn on the dashcam. The dashcam will start recording and power down.

3. Turn on the engine. The dashcam will power on and start recording. When the car is started, the dashcam will start recording and power down.
