WATER STREAM WITH 3 MODES

SELECT THE APPROPRIATE MODE ACCORDING TO THE PURPOSE OF USE

NORMAL - For normal cleaning
SOFT - For cleaning sensitive gums gently
PULSE - For cleaning gums with powerful stream of water

REPLACE THE JET TIP EASILY WITH SIMPLE BUTTON PUSH

Whole family members can use the oral irrigator with each jet tip.
Jet tips can be changed easily with simple button push.

GETTING STARTED

Charging

- 1. Insert the adaptor plug into the power outlet.
- 2. Put the device up onto the charger base.
- Red light blinks when the device is being charged, and the charging indicator becomes blue after the device is fully charged.

If the charging indicator is blinking during or after irrigating, the battery needs to be recharged.

It will take about 10 hours to charge the battery fully.

HOW TO USE

Use the oral irrigator

- 1. Attach the jet tip onto the main body. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Open the water tank cap to fill the tank with water which temperature does not exceed 40°C , and then close the cap. [Fig. 2]
- 3. Push 'H2' button to generate hydrogen water and wait 5 seconds.
- Press 'MODE' button to select the mode you want.
 During irrigation, you can change the operation mode. [Fig. 3]
- A. Normal for normal cleaning.
- B. Soft for cleaning sensitive gums gently.
- C. Pulse for cleaning gums with powerful stream of water.
- 5. Push power button to start the oral irrigator.
- 6. Hold the device in an upright position with the jet tip pointed toward your teeth.
- 7. Keep your mouth opened slightly so that the water can flow out.
- 8. Directing the water jet at 90 degree angle to the teeth & gums, shoot out water along the teeth. [Fig. 4]
- Cleaning thoroughly around any braces, crown or bridgework by shooting out water intensively at those parts.
- 10. Once irrigating is completed, press the power button to turn off the device.



AFTER USE

- 1. Open the water tank cap and pour out the water.
- Turn on the power button and drain out the water.
 Operate until no more water appears and then turn off the power button.
- 3. Stand the main unit in the charger.
- While pressing the jet tip release button, remove the jet tip from the main unit and place it on the jet tip stand.

MAINTENANCE

Use only water or neutral detergent to clean the device.

Never use caustic or abrasive agents (e.g. vinegar) as they may damage the device. Do not wash the device, using hot water of over 40° C.

Keep the device away from high temperature area and avoid direct sunlight.

Main Unit

- 1. Do not soak the main unit in water.
- Remove the dirt by wiping with a wet cloth and remove wetness with a dry cloth.
- 3. Dry the device after using it.

Water Tank

- 1. Wash with water and wipe with a soft cloth.
- 2. Dry the tank when not using for a long time.

Jet Tip

- 1. Wash with water and wipe with a soft cloth.
- 2. Replace the jet tip every 6 months. (sold separately).

Water Suction Tube

- Wash with water and wipe with a soft cloth.
- 2. Do not bend, pull or twist the water suction tube.

Charger

1. Check the charger plug and cable regularly, and use a dry cloth to wipe the charger.

Dangers

- 1. Toddlers and infants should not be allowed to use this device.
- 2. Never alter the device. Also do not disassemble it.

- 4. If the product falls into water, unplug immediately.
- 5. Do not use the product while bathing

Warnings

- 1. Never use the adaptor if it has a damaged cord or plug.
- 2. Keep the cord away from heat.
- 3. Please do not operate the device without the jet tip.
- 4. Do not fill the tank with water of over 40°C.
- 5. Do not soak the device in water.
- $\boldsymbol{6}.$ Do not use for any other purpose than oral irrigating.
- Keep the jet tip away from children. The jet tip is small enough to be swallowed and can be lodged in the throat.
- People who experience teeth or gums pain should consult their dentists before use.
- Do not press the jet tip too firmly against your teeth or gums. Doing so may injure your gums.
