




② Click the network icon of your device or go to Wi-Fi Settings of your smart device, and then select the SSID **Juplink-RX4-1800\_5G** or Juplink-RX4-1800 to join the network

Ensure that Mobile Data (if any) is disabled.

### 2. Basic connection - WPS Button

Wireless devices that support WPS, including Android phones, tablets, and most USB network adapters, can be connected to your router



① Tap the WPS icon on the device

2 Within two minutes, press the button on your router

Note: ① WPS is not supported by iOS devices.

© The WPS function cannot be configured if the wireless function of the router is disabled. Also, the WPS function will be disabled if your wireless encryption is WEP. Please make sure the wireless function is enabled and is configured with the appropriate encryption before configuring the WPS.

# **Step 3: Log In to Your Router**

① Lauch a web browser on the device which has been connected to the repeater, Enter router. juplink.com in the address bar to log in.

ted the addressing type of WAN side is DHCP, In DHCP ne address is assigned by the upper device, and the route can be connected to the network directly.

Note: Generally, the Addressing Type is DHCP. If it is PPPOE, or Static Please refer to **Method 2, Method 3**

# Method 2: Connect to the Internet - PPPoE

 $\ensuremath{\textcircled{1}}$  Select PPPoE from the Addressing Type drop-down menu



2 Enter the Username and Password provided by your ISP

③ If you forget your Username and Password, Click Get from old router Follow the instructions finish the setup

# **Method 3: Connect to the Internet - Static**

① Select Static from the Addressing Type drop-down menu



② Enter your IP Address, Subnet Mask, Default Gateway and Primary DNS, Secondary DNS

# **Step 5: Set your wireless Network** ① Modify your **Wi-Fi Name** (SSID) , **Password** (Wi-Fi password)

③ Select Dual frequency(recommended) and click Next
