#### 5.1 Antenna requirement

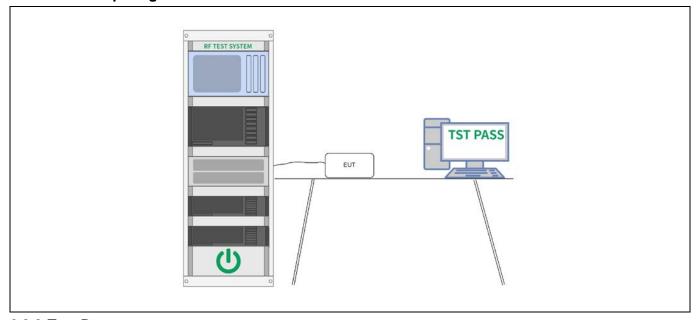
#### 6.3 Maximum Conducted Output Power

Test Requirement:	47 CFR 15.247(b)(3)
Test Limit:	Refer to 47 CFR 15.247(b)(3), For systems using digital modulation in the 902-928 MHz, 2400-2483.5 MHz, and 5725-5850 MHz bands: 1 Watt.
