### Aux-in Mode

- 1. You do not have to switch the headphones "on' for this mode.
- 2. Insert the provided audio cable into "Audio Slot" input on the headphones, and the other end of the audio cable to the playback devices output/line out.
- 3. In this mode, you can only control the playback volume with your playback device and not with the volume controls on the headphones.

#### Hands-Free Mode

- 1. To answer a call, press the answer key on your phone or press the "Answer" button on the headphone.
- 2. To hang up, press the end key on your phone or press the "hang up the call button twice on the headphone.
- 3. To redial your last call, double click the call button. Music playback will automatically be paused.

# Charging

- 1. Please ensure that the battery is fully charged before using the device for the first time
- 2. Connect the provided USB charger cable to the charging slot on the headphones. Connect the other end to the USB wall charger or to the USB port on your computer.
- 3. The LED indicator light will display a red light when charging.
- 4. LED indicator light will turn off when headphones are fully charged.


