Important safety instructions

- 5. Do not use this unit near water.6. Clean only with a dry cloth.
- 7. Do not block ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 8. Do not install the unit near heat sources such as radiators, heaters, stoves, or other equipment (including amplifiers) that heat the product.
- 9. Protect the power cord from being crushed or crushed, especially at plugs, sockets, and at the point where it exits the unit.

2. Blurry Image

Adjust the keystone, focus ring, and the projection distance.

3. USB/TF Unrecognized

Make sure your USB stick/TF card is not over 32GB.

4. No Sound

Turn off Dolby audio in your device;

If a movie's audio number is "ac3" (Dolby sound), then the sound may not be played (this kind of movie is very rare)

5. The Lamp Off

When projector is overheating ,the light will turn off automatically. Please leave the projector to cool for a few moment.

6. Connect the projector to your Smartphone / ipad.

For Android device, you need a "Micro USB/ Type C to HDMI cable" (Not included) For IOS Device, you need a "lightning to HDMI cable" (Not included)

7. Connect to computer:

Please use the HDMI cable in the package.

The USB interface is used to connect USB Flash Drive.

Place your projector


Select location

You can decide where you want to install based on your room layout or personal preferences. Consider the size and position of the screen, the location of the appropriate power outlet, and the location and distance between the projector and the rest of the equipment. The projector can be installed in one of the following locations:




1. Front display on the desk

When this position is selected, the projector is placed directly in front of the screen. This is the most common way to place a projector, and it's fast and mobile.




2. Back display on the desk

When this position is selected, the projector is located directly behind the screen. Please note that you need a special rear projection surface.



3. Back to display by hanging

When this position is selected, the projector will be hung upside down on the ceiling directly behind the screen. Please note that this installation requires a dedicated rear projection screen and a ceiling mounting kit for the projector.




4. Front display by hanging

When this position is selected, the projector is hung upside down directly on the front of the screen. Acquire a special projector ceiling kit from your dealer to mount the projector to the ceiling

Place your projector on the ceiling


- When installing the projector in the ceiling, please purchase a projector bracket recommended by an installation professional and follow the instructions supplied with the bracket.
- Before installing the projector on the ceiling, please check if the mounting structure can support the weight of the projector and the bracket. If in doubt please consult the advice of an installation.

Distance between the projector and screen


It is recommended to move the projector as close as possible to the center of the screen.



To reduce image distortion


Measure the distance between the projector and the location where you want to position the screen. This is the projection distance.

The best projection distance we recommend: 1.5-2.8m



Adjust the vertical position

Follow the picture below to adjust the vertical position.



Adjust the focus and keystone

Follow the picture below to adjust the focus and the trapezoidal screen.


Adjust the focus by turning the knob while observing the image pixels near the center of the screen. The optimal focus is achieved when the pixels are clearly visible.

Depending on the projected screen size, the focus near the edges of the screen may be less sharp than in the center of the screen.


The keystone image is created when the projector beam is projected at an angle on the screen. The keystone correction returns the distorted image to a rectangular or square shape.


Then sharpen the image by turning the focus knob.



Install / Remove the remote control battery








Note:


- Batteries must not be exposed to excessive heat, such as sunshine / fire.

The approximate steps to connect your smartphone.

Before connecting, please make sure that the projector is not connected to the power supply to avoid damage to the device.


- 1) The HDMI connector of the HDMI converter is plugged into the HDMI1/ HDMI2 interface of the projector, and the other end is inserted into the data transmission interface of the smartphone.
- 2) Turn on the projector (when the device is abnormal, you should disconnect the power in time), press the power button on the machine or the power button of the remote control.
- 3) Start to enter the machine initial screen, to enter the homepage, press the "Source" button on the remote control to select the HDMI source (if the projector has multiple HDMI interfaces, please select the corresponding HDMI interface serial number, such as "HDMI 1")
- 4) After selecting the corresponding HDMI source, the screen of the projector and Smartphone are synchronized! The connection steps for the iPad are similar to connecting a smartphone.








Type C to HDMI Adapter

The approximate steps to connect your Apple MacOS system computer

Before connecting, please make sure that the projector is not connected to the power supply to avoid damage to the device.

- 1) The HDMI interface of the converter is plugged into the interface of the HDMI 1/ HDMI 2 projector, and the other end is plugged into the Type C or Mini Display Port of the computer.
- 2) Turn on the projector (when the device is abnormal, disconnect the power supply in time), press the power button on the machine or the power button to remote control.
- 3) Start to enter the initial screen of the machine, enter the home page, press the "Source" button on the remote control to select the HDMI signal source (if the projector has multiple HDMI interfaces, please select the corresponding HDMI interface serial number, such as "HDMI 1")
- 4) After selecting the corresponding HDMI source, the projector and Computer's screen are synchronized!



Connect PC/TV Box via HDMI / VGA interface

The steps are similar to connecting a smartphone, except that no extra converters are needed (the VGA cable is in the package).

Problems when connecting smart devices

Dolby, AC3 and stereo sound can not be decoded via the USB and SD ports. We recommend using the HDMI input.

If you have no sound on the Fire TV Stick (APP: Netflix and Prime Video) due to HDCP, please turn off the Dolby output on the TV Stick.

Using Bluetooth Playback

Pairing is used when two Bluetooth devices are connected wirelessly for the first time.

This allows the devices to see each other and sets up a one-to-one communication channel between both devices.

Bluetooth Connection:

- 1. Press the button to turn on unit.
- 2. Press the button to enter the menu screen.
- 3. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select right side menu.
- 4. Use the ▲ / ▼ button to select Bluetooth column.
- 5. Press the (ok) button to enter Bluetooth menu.
- 6. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select " ON"
- 7. Turn on your External Bluetooth Speaker and select to Bluetooth pairingmode.
- 8. A few seconds, you hearing "do" sound that your unit and external Bluetooth speaker connected.
- 9. After connection completed, the unit sound to External Bluetooth speaker.

Note:

When the Bluetooth can't connect to this device automatically. Please enter to the Bluetooth setup menu and select. to the Bluetooth Reset to reset it, after that the BT device will be connected with this Projector automatically.

Disconnect the Bluetooth

- 1. Press the 🗐 button to enter the menu screen.
- 2. Use the ◀ / ▶ button to select above menu.
- 3. Use the ▲ / ▼ button to select Bluetooth column.
- 4. Press the (OK) button to enter Bluetooth menu.
- 5. Usethe ◀ / ▶ button to select " OFF" that the Bluetooth disconnect.


Tip: Bluetooth can not connect to smart devices with Bluetooth capabilities, such as smartphones, laptops, and tablets. Only Bluetooth sound playback devices can be connected.

Connect HDMI

Follow below picture to connect HDMI cable and device.

- 1. Turn off the unit before connect HDMI cable.
- 2. After connect, press the \bigcirc button to turn on unit and power indicator will light green.
- 3. Press the [2] /SOURCE button to HDMI mode and the video of HDMI device will show on projector screen. There are 2 HDMI input, HDMI1 interface corresponds to HDMI1 in SOURCE mode, and HDMI2 interface corresponds to HDMI2 in SOURCE mode.


HDMI HD signal input: this interface can be input with HD player HDMI output at the connection



Connect AV

Follow below picture to connect AV cable and device.


- 1. Turn off the unit before connect AV cable.
- 2. Connect the end of 3 heads for both Female AV cable and Male AV cable together first, and then connect the other ends of Female cable to the AV IN of projector. Similarly, connect the other ends of male AV cable to the AV OUT of the DVD player or other Electronic device which supported AV out.
- 3. After connect, press the button to turn on unit and power indicator will light green.
- 4. Press the [3] /SOURCE button to AV mode and the video of AV device will show on projector screen.



Connect VGA

Follow below picture to connect HDMI cable and device

- 1. Turn off the unit before connect VGA cable.
- 2. Press the button to turn off the power of your projector before connection.
- 3. After connect, press the 🖒 button to turn on unit and power indicator light GREEN,
- 4. Press the [2]/SOURCE button to VGA device and VGA device will show on projector screen.






Follow the picture below to connect the HDMI cable and the device.

- 1. Press the button to turn off the power of your projector before connection.
- 2. Use audio cable to connect follow below figure.
- 3. After connect and turn on both units. Your projector sound from external device now.
- 4. After using, turn off both unit.




Using the TF card and USB playback (Media Player)

Follow the picture below to connect the HDMI cable and the device.

- 1. Turn off the device in front of the USB / TF card.
- 2. Install the USB device to the USB port.
- 3. After connect, press the 🕛 button to turn on and the power indicator light GREEN.
- 4. Press the SOURCE button to enter and use buttons to search the MEDIAPLAYER mode.
- 5. After selection, use �� buttons to search the MUSIC / PHOTO / MOVIE icon and press the button to enter. If necessary, use the ◀ / ▶ button to select TF card or USB and press the button to enter.
- 6.Use buttons to search the correct file an press the ok button to preview playback file and press button of unit or button of remote to start playback.
- 7. Press button to fast search forward and rewind.
- 8. Press | button to search next or previous file.
- 9. During playback, press the bull button to pause and press again to resume.


NOTE: Remove USB / TF device, press the button to turn off power FIRST.



Sub-Menu on Movie screen

When movie playback, press the ® button and more function screen. show on lower (figure 3)

Use the ◀/▶ button to select icon and press the ⓒ button to play special function.



Using DVD playback

- 1. Press the 🖒 button to turn on unit and the power indicator light GREEN.
- 2. Press the 🔁 /SOURCE button to enter and use 🍥 buttons to search the DVD mode.
- 3. Open the disc cover and insert a playable DVD or ČD disc, make sure the label side is facing up, and then close disc cover.
- 4. The player will scan the disc, and then the playback will start automatically. If a disc menu appears on the screen, see "Using the disc menu" for details.
- 5. Press \square button to fast search forward and rewind.
- 6. Press **■** button to search next or previous file.
- 7. During playback, press the button to pause and press again to resume.

Disc handling:

- Do not leave discs near heat sources, in direct sunlight, or in high humidity.
- Store discs in their cases when they are not being used.
- Stacking discs or standing them at an angle without putting them in the case can cause the disc to warp.
- Do not touch the disc surface when handling a disc; hold it by the edges.
- Fingerprints, dust, dirt or scratches on the disc can distort the picture or reduce sound quality. Always handle carefully and make sure discs are clean before use.
- Do not stick paper or tape onto the disc.
- Do not write on the disc with a marker ,etc. Clean discs using a soft cloth, lightly wiping from the center outwards.
- Do not use solvents such as benzene, commercially available cleaner snot intended for CDs or anti-static spray intended for vinyl LPs ,as these may damage your disc.
