Safety Instructions

1. When using electrical units, basic safety precautions should always be followed. 2.Children aged from 8 years and people with reduced physical , sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge can use this unit , only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the unit in a safe way and understand the hazards involved .

3. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with unit .

- 7.Keep the unit out of reach of children .
- 8.Keep the unit away from heat or sharp edges that could cause damage .
- $9.\mbox{Keep}$ the unit away from heat sources , direct sunlight , humidity , water and any
- 10.Keep the unit free from dust lint etc .
- 11.Do not immerse the unit in water or any other liquid .
- 12.Do not operate the unit if it has been expose to water , moisture or any other liquid to prevent against electric shock , explosion and / or injury to yourself and damage to the unit .
- 13.Do not use the unit for anything other than its intended use . 14.Do not store the unit in direct sunlight or in high humidity conditions .

Special Care

Do not present the unit in direct sunlight or UV light , as the Air Pad surface (Thermoplastic Polyurethane) will be yellowing by UV .


Getting Started

Description of Parts



- 1 Power On/Off Button 2 Prev/VOL-
- (3) Play/Pause 4 Next/VOL+
- (5) Lighting Control Button (6) Charging Indicator 7 Charging Input
 - 8 AUX IN
- (9) TF Card Slot

Instructions for Use

- 1. Long pressing **Power** button to turn on the speaker .
- 2. The speaker will be default into Bluetooth mode when first turned on .
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth setting of your device and search the pairing name "NT-B809" 4. Music is ready to play after paired .
- 5. During the play, press "-" or "+" for previous or next song, keep pressing "-" or "+" can
- increase or reduce the volume
- 6. Press twice Play/Pause button to disconnect Bluetooth connection.

TF Operation

- 1. Insert TF, speaker will play the music directly.
- 2.Press Play/Pause button then pause or play the music .
- 3.During the play , press "-" or "+"for previous or next song, keep pressing "-" or "+"can increase or reduce the volume .
- *** Please don't take out TF card while playing ,otherwise , TF card will be damaged ***

Aux In Operation

- 1. Press Power button to AUX-IN mode
- 2. Insert AUX-IN cable and connect to your device to play music .

Radio Operation

- 1. Press Power button to FM Radio mode, you can listen to any radio channel of 88MHz-108MHz.
- 2. Pressing "Play/Pause" button to automatic radio scan.
- 3. Press "-" "+" change to previous and next program, keep pressing "-" "+" can reduce or increase the volume

LED Lighting Operation

press again to turn off the light.

Instructions for Use

- 1. The speaker will be default into slow breathing mode .
- 2. Press $\boldsymbol{Lighting}$ button to shift into fast breathing mode .
- 3. Press **Lighting** again change to white light color to select single color breathing, single light sequence: White - Green - Red - Blue - Pink - Yellow - Light Blue, then

TWS Operation:

- 1. Turn on two NT-B809 units and make sure without connecting other devices, keep pressing **Play/Pause** to TWS mode, then the two units will be paired, there is tone after paired successful.
- 2. Using your device to search the pairing name "NT-B809", music is ready to play

Supplement:

1. Mode Switch Sequence: BT-->TF-->FM-->AUX IN

for the two units together after paired.

- 2. Default Mode: BT
- 3. Support the memory function after disconnected under TF mode
