
QUICK START GUIDE

First Let's Check The Battery Level On Portable Charging Case

0 Open the cover and tap the power button to check the battery level

 Earpieces Automatically shut-off & charge when you put them back in the charging case.

*Charging case becomes easier to open over time



2 Check the 4 lights on the front of the case

If it shows one or no lights on please charge the case with Micro USB cable provided before pairing.

1.5 Hours will fully charge the True Wireless case.



Auto-Paring and Connecting to your Device

- Remove your earpieces from the case and they will Auto-Pair to each other.
- After roughly 5 seconds you will hear, "HELM Pairing"
- On your device turn your Bluetooth ON.
- · Open your Bluetooth window and choose-HELM True Wireless (This may take a few seconds to appear)
- · You will then hear "Connected".

NOTE: If you ever experience any connectivity issues please put your earpieces back in the case for over 20 seconds so they automatically shut off. Then take them out again.

*Tip: If you don't have your charging case with you. You can also turn the earpieces off manually by holding the smart button down for 3 seconds.

Fitting your Earpieces in Your Ears:



Gently push and twist each earpiece into your ears clockwise so the ear hook slides under the outer ear fold (helix). It should feel snug with an audible seal.

If it does not feel secure change your ear tip size included in your package.



*SAFE PRACTICE When operating the smart buttons while the earpieces are in your ears, avoid pressing into your ear canal by pinching the earpiece with your thumb and middle finger while pressing the smart button with your index finger or you can push the smart button upwards to place pressure on your upper-ear instead
