Use the power switch on the back of the keyboard to turn on the power.

- Slide up the button on the back of the keyboard to ON to turn on the power. Once the power is on, it is automatically connected to last device connected
- Slide down the button on the back of the keyboard to OFF to turn off the power.

Three Bluetooth devices can be connected simultaneously.

- Press one of the **Fn** + **[1]** **[2]** **[3]** keys for 2 seconds, then LED will be flickering, which means it is ready to pair. Select Mokibo among the list of Bluetooth devices to connect.
- After the initial pairing, the connected device can be changed by shortly pressing one of the **Fn** + **[1]** **[2]** **[3]** keys.

Select the keyboard layout that matches the OS of the connected device.

- Press one of the **Fn** + **[Windows]** **[Android]** **[Apple]** keys to select the keyboard layout for the connected devices Windows, Android, or Apple.
- The layout is auto-saved and there is no need to set up every time unless the device is changed.

Quick switch between the keyboard mode and the touchpad mode.

- Touch on the click button of the lower part of the keyboard with your finger. Then the LED will be on and the entire surface of the keyboard will become a touchpad. Press the click button and use a mouse without a touchpad. Remove your finger from the click button, then the LED will be off and the keyboard mode will be back on.

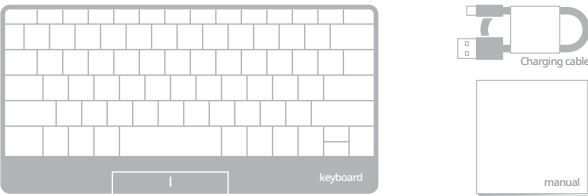
Touchpad-only mode available.

#### 1. Device using battery power

The following precautions apply to every product that uses rechargeable or disposable batteries.
