You'll want this in your hands to get it connected (not around your neck)

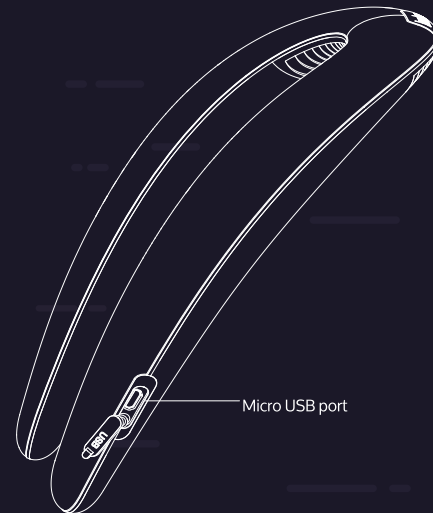
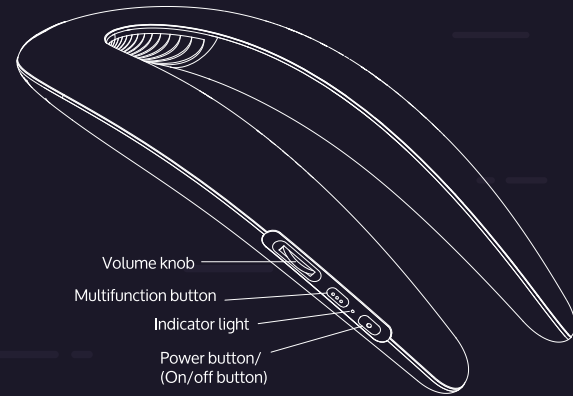
SETUP:

- 1 Connect and charge your device.
How do I know it's charging?
BLINKING RED – Low Battery
SOLID RED - Charging
BLUE (Flashing)- Pairing Mode
(Solid)- Connected to Bluetooth Device
- 2 Press and hold the power button until you hear an audio prompt.
- 3 Once powered on, the speaker will be in pairing mode. Run a Bluetooth search for NMSP300 on your wireless device and connect to your speaker.
- 4 Let the beat drop...relax with some tunes...or focus at work.
You do you, boo.

WHAT'S THIS DO?

- Power Button:
 - o Long Press = Power On/Off
 - o Short press when playing music = Play/Pause
 - o Short press when call handling = Pick up/End Call
 - o Short press 2x when call handling = Reject A Call
- Multifunction Button:
 - o Short press = Activate Voice Control
 - o Short press 2x = Fast-Forward a Track
 - o Short press 3x = Rewind a Track
 - o Long Press = Disconnect Bluetooth

The speaker will automatically shut off after 10 minutes when not connected to Bluetooth.

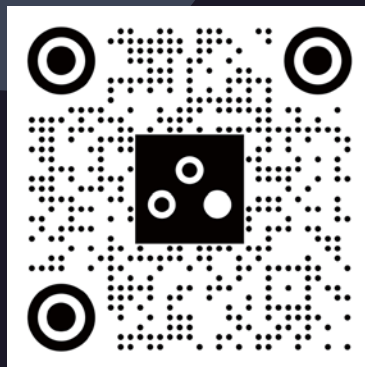
