



- Press the [ -/▶ ] button to skip to the previous track.

  Press the [ +/◄ ] button to skip to the next track.

  Long-press (3s) the [ +/◄ ] button to increase volume.

When paired to a phone via Bluetooth, you can control phone functions using the controls listed below.
