

Ear-Pieces

- “ Bluetooth Device Name: Planet Beyond
- “ Motion Key: Tapping
- “ LED Light: Green
- “ Power On: Take the ear-pieces out of the charging compartment, and the devices will turn on automatically. The left and the right ear-pieces will automatically match if worn together.
- “ Power Off: The ear-pieces will automatically turn off when putting back into the charging station.


Choosing the Earmuffs

- “ The ear-piece is equipped with the medium-sized earmuffs by default. We have provided L, M, S sizes by compliment
- “ For your comfort, we suggest you choose a pair of earmuffs that best fit your ear shape




Wearing the Ear-Pieces

“ Gently push the ear-pieces into the ear canal and rotate them to a comfortable angle.




Automatic Power On/Off

“ Take the ear-pieces out of the charging compartment for turning on.
“ Restore the ear-pieces back into the charging compartment for turning off.




Power Supply

- “ Power Display: After connecting to the mobile device, you can find the power display of the Bluetooth devices on the top bar of the screen.
- “ Low Battery Prompt: When the battery power is low, there will be a warning beep every 10 seconds.



Bluetooth Connectivity Setup

- “ For first time connection, turn on Bluetooth and find the device name <Planet Beyond> for connection. After the connection is successfully established, a beep sound will be prompted in the ear-pieces.



Control

Music Playback Control

- “ To pause: double-tap on either side to pause the music
- “ To play: double-tap on either side of the ear-piece to resume playing the music
- “ To skip: triple-tap on the right side of the ear-piece to skip to the next song
- “ To rewind: triple-tap on the left side of the ear-piece to rewind to the previous song

Incoming Call Control

- “ To answer the call: double-tap on either side of the ear-piece
- “ To reject the call: triple-tap on either side of the ear-piece
