

## RF EXPOSURE EVALUATION

### 1. PRODUCT INFORMATION

#### 2. EVALUATION METHOD

According to 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06

The 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances ≤ 50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW)/(min. test separation distance, mm)]  $\cdot [\sqrt{f(GHz)}] \le 3.0$  for 1-g SAR and  $\le 7.5$  for 10-g extremity SAR.

Where f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz

Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation

# 3. CALCULATION BR&EDR-BK3266 Chip:

Pt=-0.796dBm=0.83mW

The value of the Maximum output power P<sub>t</sub> is referred to the test report of the CFR47 §15.247.

The result for RF exposure evaluation SAR= $(0.83\text{mW} / 5\text{mm}).[\sqrt{2.480\text{GHz}}]=0.261<3.0$  for 1-g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR.

### BLE-RTL8762D Chip:

Pt=6.006dBm=3.99mW

The value of the Maximum output power P<sub>t</sub> is referred to the test report of the CFR47 §15.247.

The result for RF exposure evaluation SAR=(3.99mW / 5mm).[ $\sqrt{2.480}$ GHz)]=1.253<3.0 for 1-g SAR and  $\leq$  7.5 for 10-g extremity SAR.

## BR&EDR-BK3266 Chip+ BLE-RTL8762D Chip:

(0.261/3)+(1.253/3)=0.505

Note: The BR&EDR-BK3266 Chip and BLE-RTL8762D Chip can transmit simultaneously.

## 4. CONCLUSION

The SAR evaluation is not required.
