- 3. For conducted measurements (Output Power, Emission Bandwidth, Power Spectral Density, Spurious Emissions), the antenna of EUT is connected to the test equipment via temporary antenna connector, the antenna connector is soldered on the antenna port of EUT, and the temporary antenna connector is listed in the Test Instruments.
