

Please read the instructions carefully before using the product

Components:



Pairing: (Connecting to your phone/tablet)

- Remove both earbuds from the charging case.
- On your device, enter settings and select bluetooth. Scroll to the bottom of the screen.
- Select "friendie AIR Zen" from the devices to pair.
- Your device and headphones should now be paired. Next time, the headphones will automatically pair to each other and to the last connected device when turned on.

Charging:

Your friendie AIR Zen is powered by rechargeable li-ion batteries. Please ensure that the battery is fully charged before using the headphones for the first time.

To charge your charging case:

- Insert USB charging cable into a USB port.
- Connect USB cable into the Micro USB port on your charging case.
- Red indicator light shows the battery is charging.
- When fully charged the light will turn blue.
- It takes approximately 3 hour to fully charge the charging case.

To charge your earphones:

- Place your earphones in the charging case to charge.
- Ensure the charging lid is closed.
- Red light on the charge case shows the battery is charging.
- When fully charged the light will turn blue.
- The earphones can be charged up to six (6) times in a fully charged case, before you need to recharge the case.

Charging case controls:

Charge case indicator light	Battery low: Red light flashing. Charging: Red light displayed. Fully charged: Blue light displayed.
Earphone charging indicator light	Charging: Red light displayed. Fully charged: Blue light displayed. After 10 seconds the blue light will turn off.

Please ensure the charging lid is on and the indicator light is red to charge.

Earphone music controls:

Play / Pause	Single click the multi-function button.
Next track	Double click the multi-function button.
Volume	Volume up: Triple click right earbud. Volume down: Triple click left earbud.

Earphone general controls:

Auto On/Off	On: Remove headphones from charging case. Off: Place headphones in charging case.
Power off	Hold down multi-function button on one headphone until red light blinks.
Charging	Place earphones in the charging case. Place the charging lid on to charge.
Low battery	Red light flashes and you will hear "battery low, please recharge".
Change language	In the pairing state, double click the multi-function button on the R and L headset.

Earphone phone controls:

Answer / End	Press the multi-function button.
Reject call	Hold down the multi-function button until you hear a tone.
Mute	During a call, double click the multi-function button. You will hear a prompt "silent mode". To end mute, repeat the operation.

Troubleshooting:


Bluetooth not connecting	Restore factory pairing settings: Turn off bluetooth on your phone. With your earbuds turned off, hold down power button until they blink red and blue. Once paired only one earbud will blink blue.
Bluetooth name not appearing	Ensure earphones and device (e.g. phone) are within 8 meters with no interference. Ensure they are not paired to another device.
Dropouts occur in one ear	Ensure you have no interference from other 2.5G devices, e.g. cordless phones, WiFi.
