

Installing Baby Unit

A. Place Baby Unit on a flat surface, such as a desk or shelf.



Never place the baby unit or the cord within 1 meter of the crib

B. Connect the small plug of the power adapter to the Baby Unit and the other end to a suitable electrical outlet. Only use the enclosed adapter (5V DC 1000mA). The baby unit is turned on and the power LED will be green.






C. Connecting the power supply for the Parent Unit.


D. After pressing the SOS button, the SOS signal is wirelessly transmitted to the camera and then to the monitor




