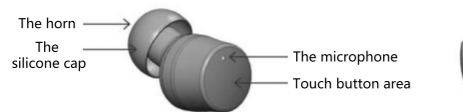


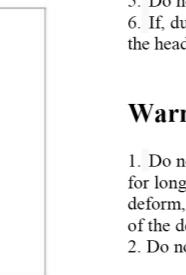
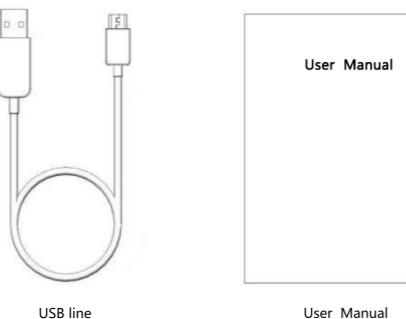

Thank you for buying the SM-02 wireless stereo Bluetooth headset, this manual will help you how to use your Bluetooth headset, before using Bluetooth headset, you must know and familiar with your headset's Bluetooth function, for you to fully enjoy your headset, start your pleasant experience

Safety rules

1. To ensure safety, please observe the rules mentioned in this manual. We recommend that you read this manual before using the Bluetooth headset.
2. Beware of sharp edges, uneven surfaces, metal parts, accessories and packaging to avoid any possible damage.
3. Please do not remove and repair this product, which may cause fire, electronic breakdown or even complete damage to the product, these are not covered by the warranty.
4. Do not wipe the appliance with oil and other volatile liquids.
5. Do not use this product in a hazardous place
6. If, during charging or use, you find that the external temperature of the headset is too high, please stop using it and contact customer service.

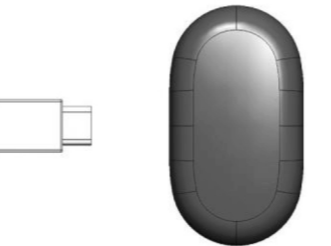
Warning

1. Do not keep the device too low or too high (below 0C or above 40C) for long periods of time, extreme temperatures can cause the device to deform, reduce the charging capacity of the device, and shorten the life of the device.
2. Do not use this device in thunderstorms, which can cause

equipment to malfunction and increase the risk of lightning strikes.
3. Keep the equipment and all accessories out of the reach of children and pets, and swallowing small accessories by mistake can cause suffocation and serious consequences.
4. Do not put the headset in water.

Charge the charging compartment:

Before first use, place the headset on the charging compartment body and connect the Type-C cable to charge the charging compartment



The digital display of the charging LED flashes for 10 seconds and goes out. LED digital display power 00-100%

Headset charging :

Put the left and right earphones into the charging

position of the charging compartment, the earphones will automatically turn off and enter the charging state. When entering the charging state, the LED of the earphones will be bright red, and when fully charged, the LED will be bright blue and go out for 3 seconds. When charging, the power of the headset will be displayed for 10 seconds.



Power on/off:

open the charging compartment cover, the headset will turn on automatically (the headset needs to be powered on), or long press the touch area for 3 seconds with "power on" prompt (flashing blue light) when it is off ; in the power on state, put the headset into the charging position of the charging compartment and close the cover with the blue light flashing, then shut down or press the touch area for 5 seconds to shut down.

How to connect TWS headset with mobile phone

Open the charging compartment cover, pick up the headset, the headset will automatically turn on. After the left and right headphones are paired successfully, the headset will automatically enter the pairing mode. At this time, open the Bluetooth interface of the mobile phone, search out the device named "sm-02" of the Bluetooth device, and click it to connect successfully; the mobile phone will display that the connection is successful



Basic operation mode of L/R headset

Reject call:
Double click the touch area 2 when calling (both left and right ears can).

Answer / end calls:

When calling, click the touch area to answer the call, and then click the touch area to end the call.

Song switching up and down:

In music mode, press and hold the touch area of the right headset for 2 seconds to hear a "beep" and release, that is, switch to the next song. Press and hold the touch area of the left headset for 2 seconds, and when you hear the "beep" and release, you will switch to the previous song.

Music pause / play:

In music mode, click music pause in the touch area of L / R headset, and then click play.

Volume up and down (+ / -):

When entering the music playing mode, when you click twice right with "beep" prompt (interval 0.4 s), the volume +; when you click twice left with "beep" prompt (interval 0.4 s), the volume -.

Siri wake-up call:

When the headset is connected to standby mode, click the right headset button 3 times.

Language switching:

Take out the charging box of a single headset, put the other headset in the charging box or turn off the headset manually. When it is not connected, touch the touch area 5 times (0.4 second interval each time).

Principal and subordinate switching:

If any headset is powered off or disconnected, the other headset can automatically remain connected and all functions can be used normally

Pairing mode of left and right earphones

1. L is the left ear, R is the right ear
2. To disconnect the headset from your phone or other Bluetooth device
3. Restore the factory settings: in the shutdown state, long press the touch for 5 seconds (L / R) to enter the pairing state, the red and blue lights flash alternately, and the red lights flash once to shut down after clearing for 3 consecutive strokes (each interval cannot exceed 0.4 seconds).

4. After restoring the settings, put the headphones into the charging compartment and take them out when the red light is on. The left and right headphones can be paired automatically. The left ear flashes red and blue alternately, and the right ear flashes once every 7 seconds, indicating that the pairing is successful



Headphone indicator description :

Power on pairing: red and blue flash alternately

Low power warning: red light once every 10 seconds

Charging: Charging: red light on; full charge, blue light off after 3S

Connect back: connect successfully: the blue light flashes once in 7 seconds. Failed to connect: the blue light flashes twice every 2 seconds until it turns off automatically after 5 minutes;

When listening to music:: breathe once in 7 seconds with blue light.

When calling: the blue light flashes once in 7 seconds;

FAQ

1	Left and right headphones can't listen to music at the same time	See left and right headphone pairing for details
2	Headphones don't charge	Check that the headphones are in place
3	Headset cannot be connected to mobile phone	Delete the associated SM-01 device on the phone and reconnect
4	Occasional signal interruption	External interference
5	There is noise in the call	Change location or close the distance between headset and sound source equipment
6	Bad signal, noisy	Please place the mobile phone on the same side of the host or away from external interference signals
7	The headset has an echo	Adjust the volume or change the place
