




PRODUCT FEATURES

- 1. Belt-driven system.
- 2. LP Vinyl Records Size: support with 7" / 10" / 12" record.
- 3. Three Speed Modes: 33 1/3 RPM, 45 RPM, 78 RPM.
- 4. The tone arm is equipped with damping lift that allows it slowly dropping down or raising up.
- 5. Built-in two stereo speakers.
- 6. Removable dust cover.
- 7. Equipped with headphone jack, Aux input jack and line output jack.
- Bluetooth Input: Users can connect their phone to the turntable via Bluetooth and use it as an amplifier. You can also connect an external speaker to the turntable to enjoy better sound. (Note: the turntable player can only support Bluetooth input, do not support Bluetooth output.)
- 9. Bluetooth Mode: the voice prompts for Bluetooth status: Di dong. The indicator light for Bluetooth status: blue.
- 10. LP Mode: the voice prompts for LP status: Di dong. The indicator light for LP status: green.


PRODUCT STRUCTURE








How to switch on:

1. Connect the power adaptor to the adaptor jack.

2.Turn the power knob clockwise to switch on the player, the power indicator will light on.

HOW TO USE THE TURNTABLE PLAYER



NOTE: for the first time of use, please remove the stylus protector.

LP Vinyl Records Play Mode:

- 1. Place the record on the turntable.
- 2. Select the correct speed, there are 33 RPM, 45 RPM and 78 RPM for choosing depends on the your record.
- 3. Push upward the tone arm lever to lift the tone arm, then slowly move it above the edge of the record. And the turntable will start spinning.
- 4. Push downward the tone arm lever, the tone arm will slowly drop down and touch the record gently. Now the record will start playing.

Warning:

- 1. Do not lower the tone arm onto the record manually, to avoid damage to the record and the stylus!
- 2. If you find the speed of the song is faster or slower than the original, then the speed that you choose does not fit your record. Please choose the correct speed and try it again.
- 3. If the auto stop switch is on, at the end of playing the record, the turntable will stop spinning, which will protect your record from being rubbed by the stylus.
- 4. If the auto stop switch is off, at the end of playing the record, the stylus will stay on the record and keep spinning, which might do some damage to both side.
- 5. If you need to stop the record manually, please push the tone arm lever upward to lift up the tone arm, and move the tone arm back to the arm holder.

Bluetooth Mode:

- 1. This turntable player can also be connected by Bluetooth device and use it as a Bluetooth speaker.
- 2. Please make sure that the auto stop switch is on, Bluetooth function only works under the auto stop switch is on, and put the tone arm back at the arm holder.
- 3. In Bluetooth mode, the indicator is blue and it will flashes quickly.
- 4. Turn on the Bluetooth function in your device, such as smart phone, tablet, laptop, and find the turntable player named "DP100". Click and make a pair with it.
- 5. After a few seconds, you will hear the sound "Di Dong", the indicator shows blue and stop flashing, which means that you successfully connect your device with the player via Bluetooth.
- 6. Now you are able to play your favorite songs on your device through the turntable player.

Note: This player can only support Bluetooth input, do not support Bluetooth output.

Aux Input Mode:

- 1. There is an aux input jack at the back of the turntable player, users can connect external audio device (such as CD player) through the aux input jack.
- 2. In aux input mode, please put the tone arm is back to the arm holder.
- 3. The player will switch into aux input mode automatically once there is audio cable insert into the aux input jack.
- 4. After you hear the sound "Di Dong", then you are in aux input mode.
- 5. When in aux input mode, the Bluetooth function will be turned off.

Line Output Mode:

- 1. Connect a 3.5 mm audio cable to the line output jack at the back of the turntable player, and plug the other end into your stereo (active speakers only).
- 2. After you hear the sound "Di Dong", then you are in line output mode
- 3. The sound will be transferred from the turntable player to your excellent external active speakers.
- 4. When you connect the audio cable into the output jack, the speakers of the turntable player will be mute.



Headphone Mode:

- 1. Connect a headphone with 3.5 mm plug to the headphone jack.
- 2. The speakers of the turntable player will be mute immediately once you insert a headphone.

ATTENTION

- 1. This product is intended exclusively for domestic use, not for commercial applications.
- 2. Do not use the product near water or any liquid.
- 3. Do not place or use the product near any heat sources, such as heater, fireplace or any device that produce heat.
- 4. Do not place the product near container that filled with liquid, like water bottle, and this product must not come into contact with water droplets or splash.
- 5. Please follow the product specification and use it under the stated voltage, unstable voltage would cause damage to the product.
- 6. Use dry cloth for maintenance only.
- 7. During thunderstorm weather or do not use the product for a long time, please unplug the product.
- Do not attempt to modify or disassemble the product by yourself, as this will directly cause damage to the product and invalidate the warranty.
